COT Cost Allocation Methodology

The cost of providing IT services for the Commonwealth consists of direct and indirect costs applied to each billable COT service. Direct costs are those associated with a COT rated service. Indirect costs are those shared by all rated services. When indirect costs are incurred, they are allocated to COT's rated services, added to the direct costs, and thereby become part of the total service cost. This gives COT the ability to bill and reconcile appropriately for each rated service. The allocation of indirect costs to COT rated services is a function within the statewide accounting system that is processed monthly.
