Dear Senator McDaniel and Representative Rudy:

As stipulated in HB352 of the 2020 Regular Session of the General Assembly, the Finance and Administration Cabinet (FAC) submits to your attention a report of the Computer Service Fund receipts from the Executive, Judicial and Legislative Branches of Government itemized by appropriation unit.

The COT cost allocation methodology follows routine cost accounting practices by aligning the cost of providing the Commonwealth's information technology services with each COT service. Each billable service includes both direct and indirect costs. Direct costs are those associated with a specific service. Indirect costs are those shared by all rated services and are allocated to COT's rated services, added to the direct costs, and thereby become part of the total service cost. This gives COT the ability to bill and reconcile appropriately for each rated service. The allocation of indirect costs to COT rated services is a function within the statewide accounting system that is processed monthly.

There were no agency rebates for Fiscal Year 2020.
