RE: 24 RS HB 6 – Monthly Facility Reporting

The 2024 Regular Session House Bill 6 requires the Kentucky Department of Corrections (DOC) to report monthly on the average occupancy rate for county jails, halfway houses, Recovery Kentucky drug treatment centers and all other community correctional residential facilities that are under contract with the state.

Below are the average occupancy rates for January 2026:

Facility Type	Average Occupancy Rate
County Jails	34.72%
Recovery Kentucky Center (SAP) - Male	80.75%
Recovery Kentucky Center (SAP) - Female	57.85%
Reentry Service Center (non-SAP)- Male	63.14%
Reentry Service Center (non-SAP)- Female	70.31%
Reentry Service Center (SAP) - Male	66.24%
Reentry Service Center (SAP) - Female	25.42%

The 2024 Regular Session House Bill 6 also requires that each contracted provider of Substance Abuse, Mental Health, and Reentry Service Centers report 100 percent of the occupancy to the Department of Corrections. This report details the total number of beds, the number of beds available, and the type of individual occupying the bed space as of January 31, 2026.
