Dear Chairman:

The 2024 General Assembly passed HB6, directing the Department of Kentucky State Police to prepare a report detailing recruitment, retention, and demographic statistics for trooper cadet classes occurring in fiscal years 2023-2024, 2024-2025, and 2025-2026. The report will include age, gender, race, education-level, and geography. The report is to be delivered on a quarterly basis beginning November 1, 2024. Following is the fourth quarterly report for fiscal year 2025.

Cadet Class 106

As of July 8, 2025, Cadet Class 106 consists of 77 applicants who are in the final stages of the application process. Of the 77 applicants the average age is 25 years, with the majority being 21 years of age. The education and work experience of the applicants are as follows:
