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### I. Program Data Report

#### 1. Executive Summary

Kentucky State University School of Nursing was awarded \$219,000 by HWC CPE for use in promotion of the nursing program and student success. Documents were submitted detailing plans that outlined areas of need. The focus was to overcome barriers that students faced. The ability to purchase food, gas, and uniform vouchers allowed students the opportunity to meet hospital requirements and attend clinicals.

#### 2. Introduction

The Clinical Doctorate (D.N.P.), Baccalaureate (B.S.N.), and Associate (A.A.S.) nursing programs at Kentucky State University located in Frankfort, KY, are accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) and the Kentucky Board of Nursing. The mission of the School of Nursing is to promote the health and well-being of all people through committed excellence to high-quality nursing education in the preparation of diverse, well-rounded, clinically competent, responsible and caring nurses – who will become – integral members of the nursing profession, active contributors to the global health agenda and improvement of the human condition, effective managers and leaders for health care, and consumers of nursing research. The Associate of Applied Science in Nursing (A.A.S.) is a pre-licensure program for those who do not hold a registered nurse license. The A.A.S. program prepares students to provide nursing care to individuals, families, groups, and communities. The program also provides a foundation for further study in nursing. Graduates of the A.A.S. program are prepared to take the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX-RN) required for practice as a registered nurse. The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.S.N.) is a pre-licensure four-year plan of study that prepares students to write the licensure examination for registered nurses (NCLEX-RN) and subsequently enter the workforce as a professional registered nurse. In addition, Kentucky State University School of Nursing offers an RN to BSN plan of study with the flexibility of online education. This option allows registered nurses who are graduates of an accredited

associate degree program to earn a B.S.N. The Doctor of Nursing Practice (D.N.P.) program is a seventy-two (72) credit hour option designed to prepare the baccalaureate registered nurse to function as an expert adult-gerontological primary care practitioner. The D.N.P. program offers a three-year (nine-semester) plan of study. The study plan requires didactic and clock-hour precepted practicum to fulfill the D.N.P. degree requirements. Courses are completed asynchronously via distance education technology with limited asynchronous face-to-face assemblies. Clinical and residency hours are typically completed within the student's region of residence with an approved preceptor.

The purpose of this report is to provide information regarding Kentucky State University School of Nursing's HWC CPE funding. Funding was received with the purpose of promoting student success, nursing program completion, and workforce growth. The funding of needed projects has been instrumental in student success and filling the urgent need for trained healthcare workers in the Commonwealth.

### **3. Healthcare Training Scholarships**

HWC CPE funding of \$219,000 has been allocated for the provision of a nursing advisor for a term of three years. 300 Students are served by this advisor. Counties of residence include Franklin, Fayette, Jessamine, Boyle, Henry, Pulaski, Shelby, Rockcastle, Madison, Scott, Bourbon, and Jefferson. Advisor duties included recruiting trips to the counties previously listed, along with Clay, Wolfe, and Letcher. Also, Project Concert dedicated for DNP students as an assistance in tracking and maintaining required clinical hours, was purchased.

### **5. Student Capacity**

Kentucky State University School of Nursing currently has 126 students enrolled in nursing courses. Limited building space to provide needed instruction, advising, and practice areas are some of the constraints faced by the School of Nursing.

## **12. Financial Barrier Reduction Actions**

Kentucky State University School of Nursing, in partnership with CHI St Joseph, offers 35 nursing scholarships that will pay for the final 2 years of the BSN program or both years of the AAS program. Upon successful completion and passage of NCLEX, the scholarship recipients will work for CHI St Joseph equal to the amount of time the scholarship paid.

HWC CPE Funding has been used to assist students experiencing hardships with covering the cost for uniforms, food, transportation to clinicals, and nursing equipment.

## **13. Conclusion**

Kentucky State University School of Nursing was successful in student achievement of 100% NCLEX passage for the BSN program and 81% for the AAS program. HWC CPE funding enabled the School of Nursing to employ a full time Coordinator of Nursing Advising and Recruitment. This employee advises approximately 300 pre-Nursing students, ensuring they matriculate through nursing prerequisites in a timely manner, and has facilitated the outreach of a recruitment program, reaching more than 800 perspective students around the Commonwealth.
