RE: Progress Report on 2004 HB 162

Dear Sirs:

This letter is in response to the reporting mandates contained in 2004 HB 162, codified as KRS 45.241 (10) (a). In accordance with these reporting responsibilities, the Finance and Administration Cabinet required all agencies to include, as a supplement in their annual closing packages, a summary of all their debts categorized as required by the legislation. Please consider this letter as part of the reporting mandates required by statute.

The Department of Revenue implemented its Enterprise Collections System (ECS) in May of 2007. Prior to this date, the Department manually collected for some agencies. The Enterprise Collections program is currently available to all state and some local authorities; contingent upon DOR agreeing to accept the debt based on available resources. The following is a brief overview of each participating agency:

For Fiscal Year 2019, there were no new agencies added to the Enterprise Collection program.

Since inception through June 30, 2019, the total collected through the Enterprise Collections program is \$190,566,457.13. Of the \$190,566,457.13 collected, \$144,941,023.33 in principal has been returned to the referring agencies. Interest totaling \$9,356,332.90 has been returned to the General Fund and \$36,269,100.90 in cost of collection fees has been used to fund collection efforts.

Collection of debt owed to the Commonwealth remains one of the Department of Revenue's top priorities. The department continues its efforts to encourage agencies to participate in the program. The General Assembly's continued support in this endeavor will be appreciated.
