24 RS HB 6 – Quarterly Recruitment and Retention Report

The 2024 General Assembly passed HB 6, directing the Kentucky State Police to prepare a report detailing recruitment, retention, and demographic statistics for trooper cadet classes occurring in fiscal years 2023-2024, 2024-2025, and 2025-2026. The report includes age, gender, race, education-level, and geography. The report is to be delivered on a quarterly basis beginning November 1, 2024. This report serves as the first quarterly report for Fiscal Year 2025.

Cadet Class 104

Recruitment for Cadet Class 104 began with the official hiring announcement on May 2, 2023. The due date for applications was August 31, 2023, resulting in 547 applications considered complete with all required documentation. The average age of applicants was 27 years with most applicants aged 22 years. The education and work experience of the applicants were as follows:

Kentucky State Police does not have a business need for the information and does not require applicants to answer these questions. Cadet Class 105

Recruitment for Cadet Class 105 began with the official hiring announcement on April 29, 2024. The due date for applications was June 30, 2024, resulting in 814 applications considered complete with all required documentation. The average age of applicants was 25.5 years with most applicants aged 25 years. The education and work experience of the applicants were as follows:
