Eastern Kentucky SAFE Fund – no applications have been denied

Western Kentucky SAFE Fund:

- Dawson Springs Independent Schools sought funding for revenue loss prior to the amendments to the SAFE Fund by the 2022 Special Session, which now permits it with specific conditions on timeframe and amount.
- Fulton County
 - o 1) sought funding for a fire station generator that was not damaged by the storm,
 - 2) sought funding for the replacement of fire equipment for a volunteer fire department that isn't a part of the county government; therefore, not an eligible entity under the statute.
- Graves County sought funding for a non-profit entity to construct a homeless shelter; therefore, not an eligible entity under the statute. The entity is applying to FEMA.
- Western Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative sought funding for equipment that was not damaged by the storm.
