Subject: SAFE Fund Denied applications

Eastern Kentucky SAFE Fund – no applications have been denied

Western Kentucky SAFE Fund:

- Dawson Springs Independent Schools – sought funding for revenue loss prior to the amendments to the SAFE Fund by the 2022 Special Session, which now permits it with specific conditions on timeframe and amount.
- Fulton County
 - 1) sought funding for a fire station generator that was not damaged by the storm,
 - 2) sought funding for the replacement of fire equipment for a volunteer fire department that isn't a part of the county government; therefore, not an eligible entity under the statute.
- Graves County – sought funding for a non-profit entity to construct a homeless shelter; therefore, not an eligible entity under the statute. The entity is applying to FEMA.
- Western Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative – sought funding for equipment that was not damaged by the storm.
