The mission of the Department of Housing, Buildings, and Construction is to protect the life and property of the citizens of the Commonwealth through educational, licensing, plan review, permitting, inspection, and compliance programs in the administration of codes and standards relating to the construction and maintenance of buildings and structures pursuant to KRS Chapters 198B, 224.60, 227, 227A, 236, 318 and KAR Title 815. DHBC accomplishes this mission by providing oversight of building construction through enforcement of building and fire codes to include: building plan review and inspection, plumbing plan review and inspection, boiler inspection, HVAC inspection, electrical inspection, elevator inspection, manufactured housing inspection, recreational vehicle inspection, and hazardous materials plan review and inspection. DHBC also ensures fire and life safety in existing buildings; licenses/certifies plumbers, boiler contractors, HVAC installers, electricians, elevator mechanics and contractors, manufactured housing installers and retailers, recreational vehicle retailers, underground storage tank installers, sprinkler contractors and inspectors, fire alarm inspectors; and serves as the headquarters for the State Fire Marshal.

Included in the enacted 2022-2024 Executive Budget is the following report submission requirement:

The Department of Housing, Buildings, and Construction shall submit a report to the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue by December 01 of each fiscal year detailing the number of full-time inspectors and reviewers, in addition to the number of completed inspections and plan reviews.
