# 2024 Regular Session created GRANT Program of 2024 in House Bill 723


- Administered by the Cabinet for Economic Development
- \$200 million appropriation

**Program Eligibility – Grant Recipient** 

#### **APPLICANT MUST BE:**

- 1) City
- 2) County
- 3) 501(c)(3) organization
- 4) Subdivision of a city or county

Applicant for GRANT Program of 2024 must match the applicant for the federal grant/program



#### Program Eligibility – Federal Grant Sponsoring Agency

# Federal Grant MUST be sponsored/administered by:

- US Dept of Housing & Urban Development (HUD)
- 2) Delta Regional Authority (DRA)
- 3) 12 federal agencies comprising the Interagency Working Group (IWG) on Coal and Power Plant Communities and Economic Revitalization





#### **Federal Grant Requirement**

### Federal Grant/ Program MUST

- Require matching funds
- Decision date no more than 12 months prior to or after application date


Projects are limited to the minimum matching funds required by the federal grant/program



### **Eligible Project**

## **ELIGIBLE PROJECT – Benefits the Public and Initiated on:**

- Publicly owned property
- Property to be acquired with either:
  - LOI or Option for Sale
  - Sale Agreement
- Private property in the public interest and for a public purpose/benefits community



#### Other Requirements



#### **Local Match Required:**

- Statutory calculation based on population
- 1% to 5% of GRANT Program funds

#### **Scoring Required:**

- Based on Return on Investment and Relative Positive Impact
- Minimum of 60 points to qualify

#### **Process**





Applications due by the

1st of each month – all
applications should be

Preliminary evaluation completed within 5 days



Review, Score,

Finalized by the end of each month if completed application was received without any errors or omissions

Approval emails sent by 21st of each month


