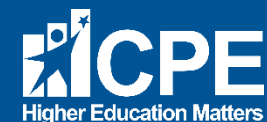

Highlights

Public – Private Partnerships (PPPs)

- States are applying this model to strengthen talent pipelines in response to critical workforce needs – specifically Louisiana and Florida
- Many states are looking to Kentucky as a model for innovative, public-private solutions.
- Kentucky's HWIF inspired the federal legislation - H.R. 9812 - the “Health Care Workforce Investment Act”

Healthcare Workforce Investment Fund

- Established in 2023 through HB 200
- \$10 million appropriation in 2024

AERO Act

- Aerospace is KY’s #1 export; growing overlapping sectors
- Urgent need for qualified pilots, mechanics, engineers, air traffic controllers
 - SB 87 - Air Traffic Control feasibility
- Industry partners and postsecondary institutions excited about this opportunity

- 9 healthcare training programs awarded across 6 institutions
- \$2,457,672 awarded (14% of total)

- 3 healthcare training programs awarded
- \$662,244 awarded (3% of total)

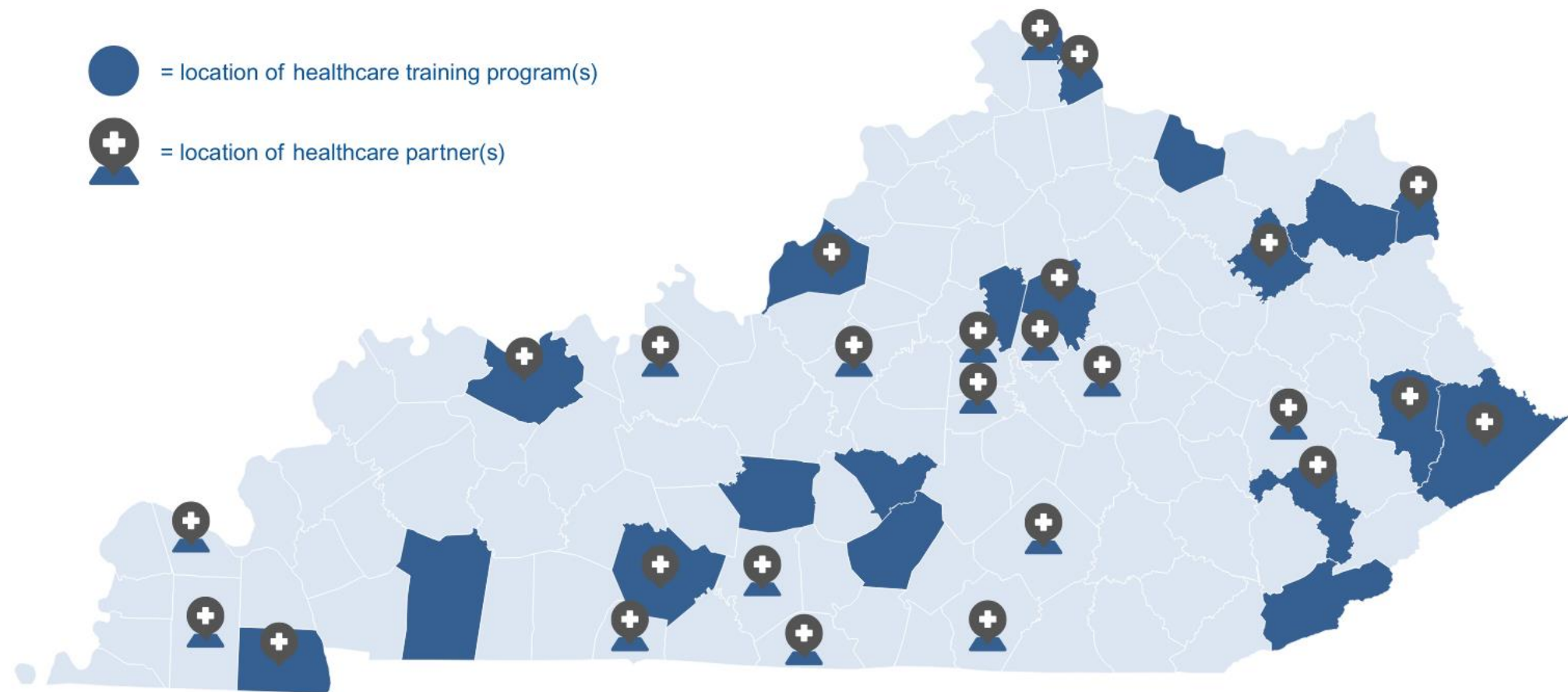

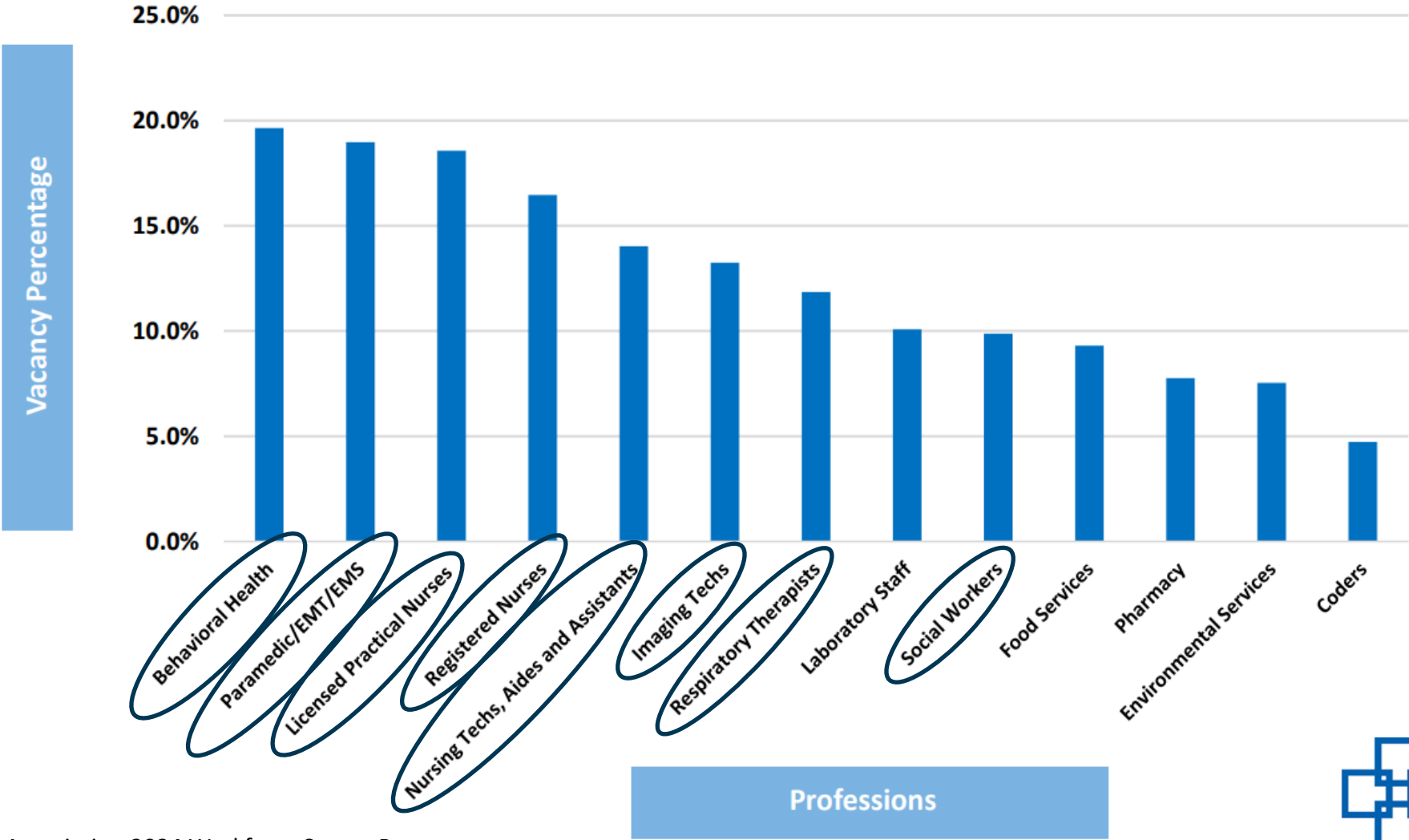

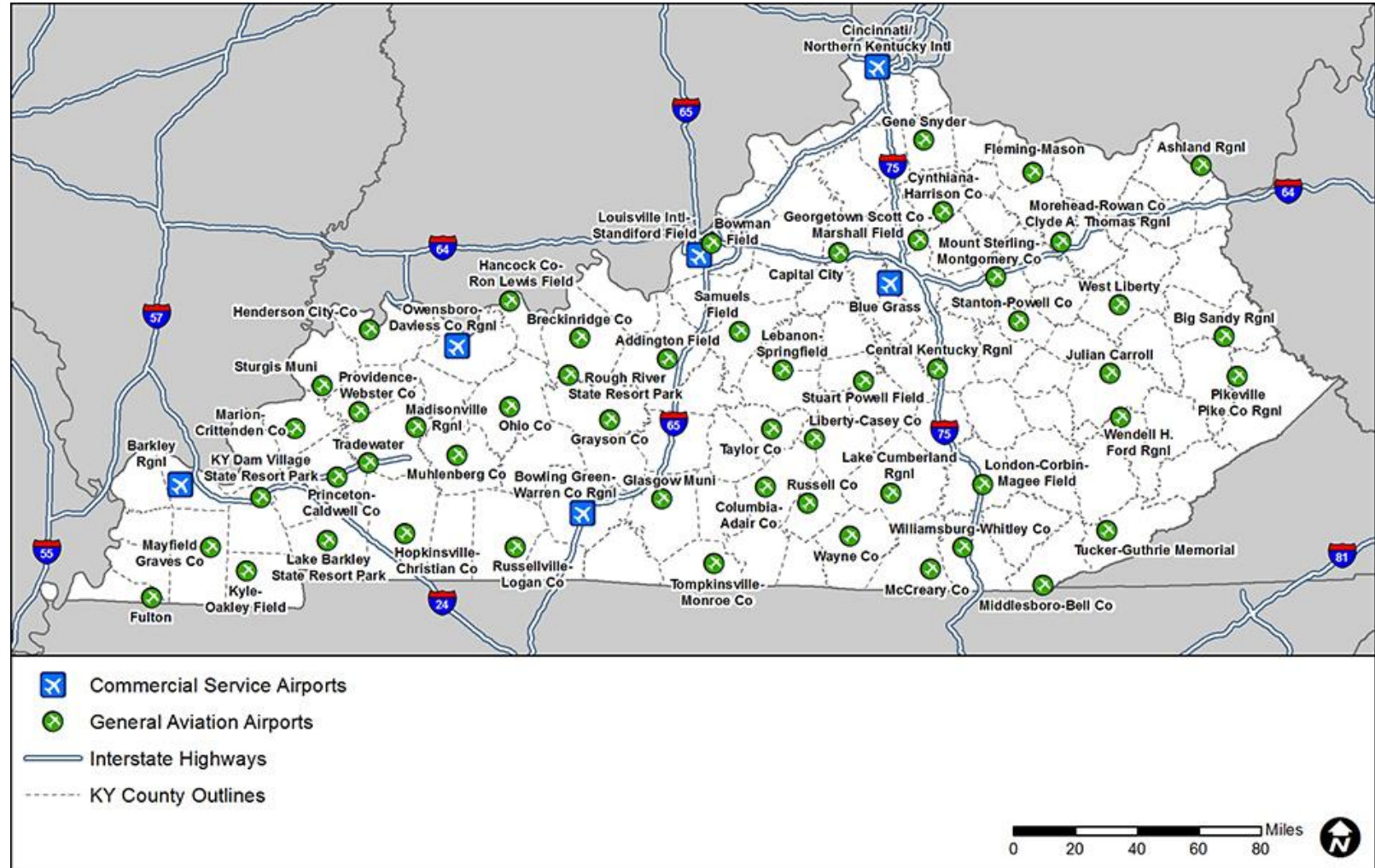

Future Directions

HWIF

\$20 million in appropriations with a partnership match means:

- Scholarships: at least \$25 million
- Incentive Awards: up to \$13.5 million

Healthcare training scholarships can get the following into the workforce:

- 2,100 respiratory therapists and/or radiologic technologists
- 1,000 registered nurses (BSN)
- 550 social workers (MSW)
- 208 – physician assistants

AERO Act

\$15 million in appropriations with a \$15 million partnership match means:

- Scholarships: \$19.5 million (at least)
- Equipment Grants: \$10.5 million (up to)

Scholarships can get the following into the workforce:

- 750 mechanics
- 75 pilots
- 30 engineers

Grants will ensure:

- Schools can train quality, high skilled employees
- Employers able to retain employees
