Dear Secretary Hicks:

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet is a First Quarter Federal Fund appropriation and allotment increase in the amount of \$65,128,500 in General Administration and Support.

This appropriation and allotment increase is necessary to establish spending authority for federal funds available to the Cabinet from the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA). This Act establishes the Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Formula Program which will provide funding to strategically deploy electric vehicle charging infrastructure. The Cabinet is working with developers, who will be expending 100% of the funds for this project and will be requesting the 80% Federal Funds reimbursement from the Cabinet. The developers will be providing the 20% match of \$13,025,700.
