Impact of COVID-19

- FY 2019-20
 - \$445,800 (-1%) State Appropriation Rescission
 - \$4.5 million refunds Housing and Dining
 - Auxiliaries losses \$1.2 million
 - Lost revenue due to University event cancellations
 - NCAA revenue loss
 - Education Abroad refunds
 - Instructional cost increases
 - Technology cost increases
 - Federal Enhanced Sick and Leave Provision Cost Increases
 - Impact of COVID-19 on Self-Insurance Claims
 - Among many other areas...
 - Total: ~\$7.8 million



Impact of COVID-19

- \$7.8 million reduction in operating budget for FY 2020-21
 - Two year decline of \$14.5 million
 - Appropriation change Performance Funding
 - \$827,600 reduction for FY 2020-21
- Since FY 2007-08...20% appropriations decrease
- 54 positions paused/eliminated
- 111 positions eliminated SSC Services
- Strategic Investments
 - Academic enhancements Online growth New programs
 - Diversity, Equity and Inclusion initiatives
 - Scholarships
 - Murray State Promise Need-based aid
 - Among others...

Impact of COVID-19

- Adjustments to FY 2020-21 budget
 - No tuition increase
 - Enrollment and retention
 - Hiring freeze
 - Elimination of positions
 - Elimination of overtime
 - No COLA
 - Expenditures above \$2500...VP/President approval
 - Review of contracts in every area of the University
 - Travel
 - Efficiency of operations review
 - Among many other changes



CARES Act

- Emergency Student Aid
 - \$3.135 million total
 - Round 1: 1561 Grants \$1.28 million
 - 33% of our Pell students received
 - Round 2: 645 applications
 - Round 3: Opens soon
- Institutional Aid
 - \$3.135 million
 - Housing and Dining reimbursements (\$4.5 million)
 - Total deficit ~\$7.8 million
- GEERS Funds
- Coronavirus Relief Fund



Racer Restart – Fall 2020

- Comprehensive Racer Restart Plan
 - ~200 faculty, staff, students, administrators and healthcare professionals
 - Murraystate.edu/racerrestart
- Racer Safe & Healthy
 - Detailed plan to ensure the health, safety and well-being of our students, faculty, staff and community
 - Impacts: People-Academics-Facilities-Athletics to Student activities...every area of the University
 - Fall 2020 a new normal, on-campus semester with many tweaks and adjustments





The Road Ahead

- Needed investment in public higher education
- Pension issues
- Improving performance funding model
- Ensuring access and affordability

 Student debt, retention, completion
- Continued commitment to underrepresented minorities and low-income students
- Managing enrollment (71% of budget today)
- Funding to increase need-based scholarships
