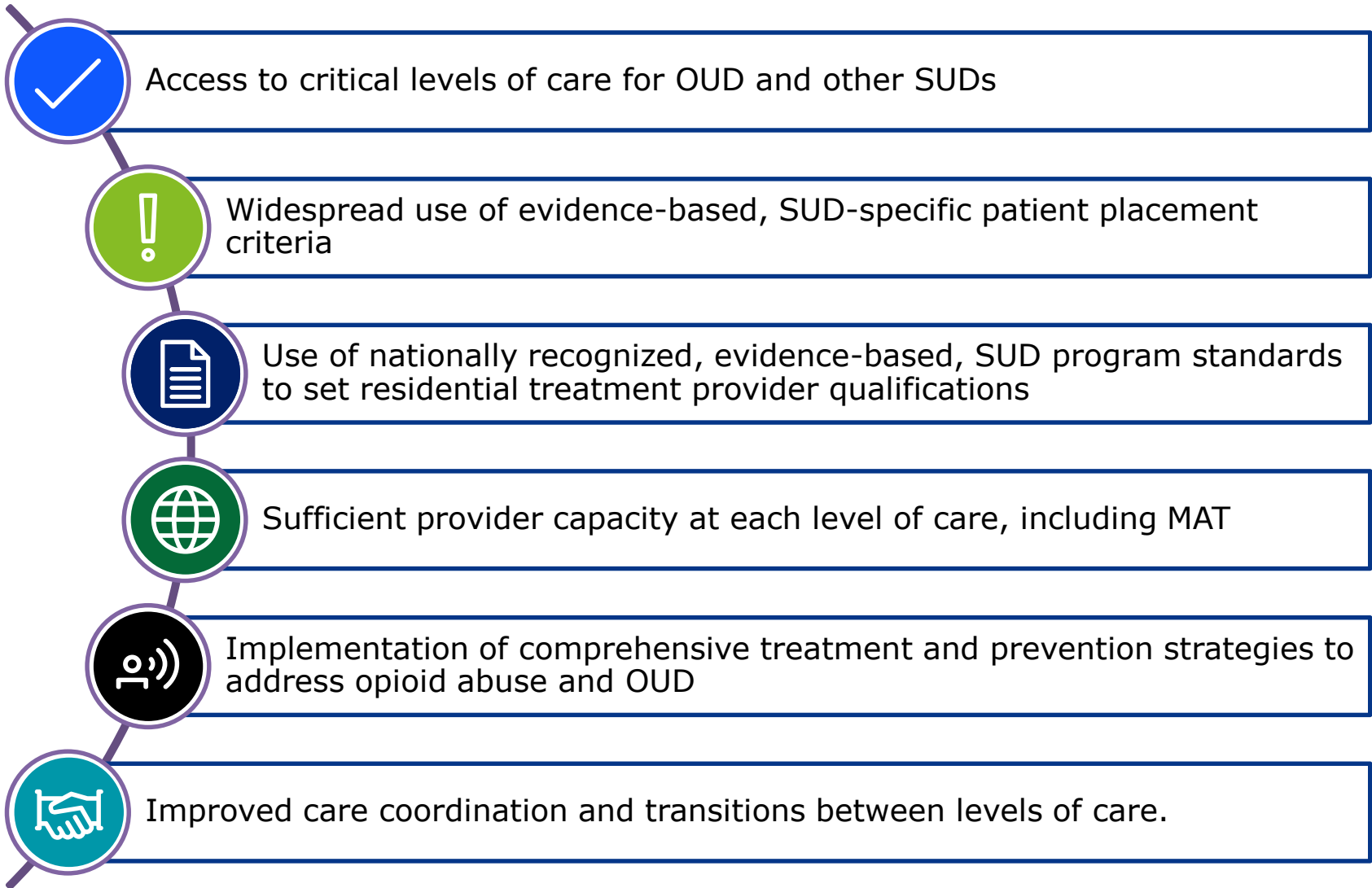

1115 Substance Use Disorder Demonstration and Timing

The Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approved the 1115 Demonstration on January 12, 2018. The demonstration will be effective January 12, 2018 through September 30, 2023.

In order to move forward with the proposed 1115 Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Demonstration, DMS was required to submit a SUD Implementation Protocol within 120 calendar days upon 1115 Demonstration approval.





Provider certification to residential level of care and possible waiver of the IMD exclusion to increase bed capacity for more access to treatment

Waive of NEMT for Methadone services

Added supports for care coordination

Required multi-dimensional assessment (based on ASAM criteria) to determine medical necessity and appropriate level for a "person-centered" length of stay

Phase 1 (7/1/19)

Waiver of IMD Exclusion

State Plan Amendment Changes

- Applying ASAM criteria
- Peer support guidelines
- Expanded MAT coverages to include Methadone in a NTP
- Including care coordination in residential
- Adding withdrawal management

Regulation Changes

- Behavioral Health Organization (BHSO) redesign
 - Tier I mental health outpatient
 - Tier II SUD outpatient/narcotic treatment program (outpatient)
 - Tier III SUD residential BHSO

Phase 2 (1/1/20)

Residential certification

- Tier III SUD residential BHSO
 - Clinically managed low-intensity residential services (3.1)
 - Clinically managed population-specific high-intensity (3.3)
 - Clinically managed high-intensity (3.5)

IMD Exclusion Evaluation

- Site visits for certification of residential treatment providers conducted by DMS.
