Barbourville Ind - \$3,220,000 estimated – Phase II Improvements at Barbourville city school are planned. State estimated annual debt service is \$33,231 and local is \$205,703. No tax increase is necessary to finance this project.

Grayson County - \$1,105,000 estimated – Roofing projects at HW Wilkey Elementary and Oran Lawler are planned. State estimated annual debt service is \$43,059 and local is \$41,758. No tax increase is necessary to finance this project.
