Dear Senator Girdler and Representative Thomas:

Pursuant to KRS 45.760(5), the University of Kentucky (UK) hereby reports the purchase of medical equipment in excess of \$200,000, Phillips Digital Pathology System. Money specifically budgeted and appropriated by the General Assembly for another purpose or program is not being used for the expenditures of this item.

The Phillips Digital Pathology System will be used by the UK HealthCare A.B. Chandler Hospital. This system will establish the essential foundation and infrastructure for the conversion from microscope-based glass slides to the use of digital pathology. The system is for clinical use and advanced imaging analytics. Through facilitating high performance viewing and enabling flexible consultation management, digital whole slide images and consult information can be exchanged easily between pathologists, and across external institutes. Improving connectivity between labs reduces the logistical challenges of the traditional consultation in which the physical shipping of glass slides is costly and time consuming. The cost is \$373,430.60 to be paid in cash with UKHC restricted funds.

Dear Senator Girdler and Representative Thomas:

Pursuant to KRS 45.760(5), the University of Kentucky (UK) hereby reports the purchase of medical equipment in excess of \$200,000, Radon Del Medical Vision R C-Arm. Money specifically budgeted and appropriated by the General Assembly for another purpose or program is not being used for the expenditures of this item.

The Radon Del Medical Vision R C-Arm will be used by the UK HealthCare A.B. Chandler Hospital. The equipment is a feature rich, mobile surgical system designed to perform a wide range of fluoroscopic applications. It offers refined movement capabilities, high resolution, and dose efficiency for procedures in surgery: orthopedics, urology, cardiology; and pain management. This equipment will be used to support intraoperative procedures in the operating room. Patients will benefit from dynamic visualization, which can visualize the smallest anatomical structures – improving interventional vascular and cardia procedures. The cost is \$229,905 to be paid in cash with UKHC restricted funds.
