Dear Secretary Johnson:

The Kentucky State Police requests approval of a \$1,400,000 emergency repair, maintenance or replacement project to purchase a used helicopter that is necessitated by an unforeseen mechanical breakdown, electrical breakdown, or structural defect that must be corrected to make an item of equipment usable. This request is in accordance with KRS 45.750(1)(g), (2) and (3), and 45.780.

During a routine 100/300 hour inspection, our Bell OH 58C helicopter was found to have several maintenance issues. Two of these issues are considered major and make the aircraft not airworthy. One issue was that the vertical tail fin's leading edge was found to be delaminating and coming off. Due to the age (over 50 years old) of the aircraft and the fact that the manufacture has discontinued production of this airframe, there is not a replacement part readily available. The second issue is a crack in the front right windscreen. This crack has been present for several years and has increasingly progressed. It has now reached a limit were it is a safety of flight issue. As with the vertical fin, due to the age and shape of the windscreen, replacement parts are not readily available.

Recently, the Kentucky State Police was made aware that the FBI is selling a 2005 Bell 407 helicopter and is willing to negotiate for a direct sale. The helicopter is in very good condition and could be utilized almost immediately after installation of KSP communications.

The Kentucky State Police uses its helicopters to respond to various aviation requests that support: our own missions, local law enforcement agencies, Kentucky Emergency Management in times of natural disaster, active shooter, executive transport, search and rescue, missing persons, and a variety of other missions. Replacing this helicopter will ensure that the Kentucky State Police has the capability to continue to respond to these missions and maintain government operations. The immediate / emergency



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replacement of this helicopter is critical to the KSP to provide airborne law enforcement services to the Commonwealth.

Funding for this project includes \$700,000 from the Capital Construction and Emergency Repair, Maintenance and Replacement account and \$700,000 from available funds within the Kentucky State Police's budget (\$350,000 from available restricted funds and \$350,000 from the General Fund).
