The Cabinet has determined that remediation/replacement work needs to begin as soon as possible.

The project consists of the selective demolition and subsequent renovation of areas in the existing Readiness Center which was originally constructed in 1985. The demolition work includes the removal of existing windows, demolition of existing latrines, removal and subsequent offsite disposal of existing architectural finishes, acoustic ceiling systems, vinyl flooring, and doors required to accommodate new building improvements. In addition, demolition includes disassembling existing mechanical, electrical, data and communications systems within the affected work area to facilitate new construction. The renovation to be performed includes the installation of new Antiterrorism/Force Protection (AT/FP) compliant windows and storefront, updating the existing male and female latrines with new lactation room including new fixtures and finishes, new hollow metal doors and frames, new door hardware, new acoustic tile ceilings at selected locations, new carpet tile in offices, polished concrete in hallways, and epoxy flooring in existing kitchen and latrines. The project will also reconfigure the existing Rifle Range into a new Classroom for additional instruction space as well as a new Training/Simulation Devices Room to operate and store a 5-lane Engagement Skills Trainer (EST). Within existing Unit Storage and Locker Room, it will provide new mesh partitions for storage and a new space for Organizational Clothing and Individual Equipment (OCIE) lockers and storage and install new Interior LED lighting fixtures with occupancy sensors and fully integrate the VRV controls with existing Automated Logic platform.

Authorization is requested, pursuant to KRS 45,760, for approval of a new Capital Construction project to renovate the Springfield Readiness Center in Springfield, Ky, This appropriation request for \$1,700,000 is federally funded. This appropriation request is for the award of the construction contract and design/construction contingency.

The project consists of the selective demolition and subsequent renovation/restoration of areas in the existing Readiness Center, which was originally constructed in 1979. The demolition work includes the removal of existing deteriorated male latrines and showers, as well as utilizing existing spaces within the Readiness Center to include updated latrine, showers, and a lactation room for female Soldiers.

The renovation to be performed includes increasing the size of the current vault (approximately 240 SF) to 600 SF to accommodate new secure storage requirements, and reconfiguring the Unit Storage, Locker Room, and Battalion Supply areas to include a new space for Organizational Clothing and Individual Equipment (OCIE) lockers and storage as well as adequately sized Unit Storage areas for the assigned units. The administrative and common areas of the Readiness Center will have installations of new acoustic tile ceilings at selected locations, new paint on walls, new carpet tile in offices, polished concrete in hallways, and epoxy flooring in the existing kitchen and installation of new interior LED lighting fixtures with occupancy sensors in all areas of the Readiness Center.
