Unemployment Insurance System Maintenance and Support Upgrades

In accordance with KRS 48.760(7), the Education and Labor Cabinet requests approval of a 100 percent Federal funded capital information technology project, Unemployment Insurance System Maintenance and Support Upgrades. The funding of this project will be 100 percent provided by the US Department of Labor. The security and software maintenance of the UI system must be maintained. The Customer Relationship Management (CRM) system handles sensitive personally identifiable information (PII) and is on version 2015, six versions out of date. Additionally, the UI database management system's software support (ver.12.2) ended in Nov 2020 and no longer receives security patches, etc., for the protection of the system and its data. In today's climate of cyber-attacks, ransomware, and massive data breaches, it is critical we maintain software versions that are supported and continue to be patched for vulnerabilities.

The Education and Labor Cabinet is in the process of selecting a vendor to provide a completely new and modernized Unemployment Insurance System. However, with the implementation timeline is expected to be in excess of 18 months, these system upgrades are critical for the current system.

This \$2,000,000 project will reduce vulnerabilities, operational risks, and make value-driven improvements to the claims/benefit processing capabilities of the UI system. Funding for this project is available and approved by the Executive Director, Office of Unemployment Insurance budget team. Components of this project include bringing aging software and hardware onto supported versions and platforms and align with COT's security posture.

Report of Capital Project Scope Increase

Kentucky Community and Technical College System

Dear Secretary Johnson:

The Kentucky Community and Technical College System (KCTCS) respectfully requests approval, pursuant to KRS 164A.575.(15), of a capital construction project scope increase for \$800,000 for the Elizabethtown Community and Technical College Student Center Renovation. This project received authorization in the 2016-2018 budget for \$4,300,000.

This project will provide necessary services to students: College Credit Transfer Office, Coding Academy Classroom Laboratory, meeting spaces for Student Government and other student organizations and Food Service/ Student Community space.

This project was bid on November 23, 2021 and rebid on February 9, 2022, and current construction market conditions have caused an increase in material and labor costs and are expected to continue into the near future. Due to bids coming in over budget, KCTCS is requesting approval to increase the scope of the project by \$800,000, which will be funded from agency funds. The design and construction of the project is being pursued through the Finance and Administration Cabinet. KCTCS Board of Regents approved the scope increase at their December 3, 2021 meeting.
