Subject: Sundry Medical and Research Equipment

Dear Senator Girdler and Representative Freeland and Honorable Members of the Capital Projects and Bond Oversight Committee:

Pursuant to KRS §45.760(5), the University of Kentucky hereby reports the purchase of the following item of research equipment in excess of \$200,000. Money specifically budgeted and appropriated by the General Assembly for another purpose or program is not being used to acquire this item.

The College of Engineering has purchased a L3 Model Machine from MELD Manufacturing. A cooperative research agreement between UK and the U.S. Army Research Laboratories requires advanced additive manufacturing technologies be employed for novel material processing and additive manufacturing of Deparement of Defense (DoD) relevant materials systems. The L3 Model Machine is an Additive Friction Stir Deposition System that relies on a thermomechanical process to build components additively rather than through melting and solidification mechanisms. The inherent characteristics of this process make it ideal for the range of material systems relevant to DoD applications. The total cost of the research equipment was \$607,500 and the equipment was purchased with federal funds from an U.S. Army Research Office grant. This equipment will be located at the Center for Robotics & Manufacturing Systems Building in Lexington, Kentucky.
