Pursuant to KRS 45.750(1)(g) and 45.780, the Secretary of the Finance and Administration Cabinet has approved an Emergency Repair, Maintenance, or Replacement capital project for the State Police Supply Branch Facility Fire July 2024 in the amount of \$2,430,500. This project is funded with \$2,420,500 from insurance reimbursement and \$10,000 from the 2024-2026 Maintenance Pool.

On July 26, 2024, the Kentucky State Police Supply Branch Facility, located at 94 Airport Road, Frankfort, KY. 40601, received fire and smoke damage to the entire facility. The fire started in the warehouse section which caused structural damage to the flat roof. State Risk has been involved with the project since initiating the insurance claim FT-0085. The Division of Engineering and Contract Administration (DECA) has been involved with the project to help move forward with operationalizing the building. ServPro, who is a Master Agreement Vendor, has performed mitigation work and provided proposals for restoration work to be completed. DECA will coordinate structural, electrical, and roof replacement, the construction of warehouse office space, and HVAC replacement in the warehouse.
