#### Pool Project in Excess of \$1,000,000

Postsecondary Education, Kentucky State University:

- McCullin Hall Renovation project in the amount of \$2,000,000 funded with \$434,782.61 from bond funds and \$65,217.39 in Restricted Funds from the 2022-2024 Asset Preservation Pool and \$1,500,000 from bond funds from the 2024-2026 Asset Preservation Pool.
- 2. Walkway Improvements and Miscellaneous Repairs project in the amount of \$1,750,000 funded with \$652,173.91 from bonds funds and \$97,826.09 in Restricted Funds from the 2022-2024 Asset Preservation Pool and \$1,000,000 from bond funds from the 2024-2026 Asset Preservation Pool.
- 3. Academic Services Building Roof and Windows project in the amount of \$2,000,000 funded with \$12,697.07 from bond funds from the 2008-2010 Capital Renewal Pool, \$642,212.96 from bond funds from the 2020-2022 Roof Repair and Replacement Pool and \$1,345,089.97 from bond funds from the 2024-2026 Asset Preservation Pool.

The project will renovate the exterior of McCullin Hall to address water infiltration issues and will consist of repairs to the exterior building envelope, stairs, doors, and deteriorating concrete as well as complete window replacement. Dear Secretary Johnson,

In accordance with provisions of 2022 Kentucky Acts, Chapter 199, Part II, I., (1) and 2024 Kentucky Acts, Chapter 175, Part II, I., (1), I am writing to report the McCullin Hall Renovation Project at Kentucky State University. The project budget is \$2,000,000 and will be funded using \$500,000 from the 2022-2024 Asset Preservation Pool, which consists of \$434,782.61 from the Asset Preservation Bond Funds and \$65,217.39 in University funds, for the required 15% match and, \$1,500,000 from the 2024-26 Asset Preservation Bond Funds which require no match.

The building suffers from deferred site maintenance, lack of building upgrades, and unaddressed moisture issues, as well as failing, dated, deteriorating, or damaged architecture (both exterior and interior). This renovation will consist of exterior renovations which include, the building envelope, complete window replacement, stair replacement/repair and deteriorating concrete and door systems.

The Kentucky State University Board of Regents approved this project on January 31, 2025 and the Council on Postsecondary Education approved this project on April 18, 2025.

Dear Secretary Johnson,

In accordance with provisions of and 2024 Kentucky Acts, Chapter 175, Part II, (4) and Part II, I., (1), I am writing to report the Academic Services Building Roof and Window Replacement Project at Kentucky State University. The project budget is \$2,000,000 and will be funded using \$1,345,089.97 from the 2024-2026 Asset Preservation Bond Funds, \$12,697.07 from the 2008-2010 Capital Renewal Pool, and \$642,212.96 from the 2020-2022 Roof Repair and Replacement Pool.

The Academic Services Building currently has a roof that has exceeded its useful life, as well as windows and window seals that are failing. These issues are causing water infiltration into the building in many areas. This project will replace the roof, as well as replace, where necessary, existing windows and completely seal all windows.

The Kentucky State University Board of Regents approved this project on January 31, 2025 and the Council on Postsecondary Education approved this project on April 18, 2025.
