Capital Project Scope Increase

Dear Co-Chairs Frommeyer and McPherson:

The Kentucky Community and Technical College System (KCTCS) respectfully request approval, pursuant to KRS 45.760, of a capital construction project scope increase for \$1,200,000 for the Fire Commission Fire Academy Maintenance Building project. The current 2024-2026 capital budget authorization for this project is \$2,000,000. The revised budget for this project will be \$3,200,000 and the source of funding will be restricted funds.

This project will construct a maintenance building on the Fire Commission Fire Academy site in Greenville, KY. It will be a part of the strategic facility plan that is in place for this site. It will house fire pumpers and equipment that will be used for training firefighters at our new Fire Academy.

After designing the building, it has been determined that an additional \$1,200,000 is needed for the construction of the building. Additional square footage is being added to the building to house larger restroom/ locker room facilities that will be available for trainees practicing on the fire tower nearby and additional subsurface work is necessary requiring additional engineered fill due to poor soil conditions.

The design and construction of these projects is being implemented through KCTCS Facilities Support Services Capital Construction Division. KCTCS Board of Regents will be approving this project on March 12, 2026.
