Dear Secretary Johnson,

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) requests a capital project per KRS 45.760 (7)(a) for the KYTC Hardin County I-65 Southbound Commercial Motor Vehicle Station Relocation project. The project scope is \$13,000,000 (\$80,600 Road Fund, \$12,919,400 Federal Funds). Federal Funds will come from the Federal Highway Administration.

This project will include a complete demolition of the existing Hardin County vertical structures to be replaced with structures located on an alternative site. The new office building will allow scale monitoring with views in four directions, a customer service area, new restrooms, six offices, a mechanical room and an attached three bay garage. The inspection bay size will be doubled and there will also be two inspection barns. This project was the subject of a Kentucky Transportation Center (KTC) study which considered how best to improve safety inspections and aid in the collection of revenue.

CCAT – LSCC Campus Wide Roof Repairs/Replacements

The Department of Corrections (DOC) would like to request approval to report project CCAT – LSCC Campus Wide Roof Repairs/Replacements, in the amount of \$7,082,100 to the Capital Projects and Bond Oversight Committee pursuant to 2024 Regular Session, House Bill 6, Part II (4) Appropriations for Project Not Line Itemized. This project will be funded with Bond Funds from CBSD-Maintenance Pool 2024-2026.

This project consists of reroofing work at the Little Sandy Correctional Complex (LSCC) in Sandy Hook, Kentucky. The scope of work includes five (5) State Houses, two (2) General Housing Units, one (1) Facility Building, the Minimum-Security Unit, the East Region Training Center, the Restricted Housing Unit, and the Gym/Chapel/Academic Building.

Approximately 196,440 square feet of existing roof will be removed and replaced. The existing roof systems include two-ply modified bitumen, asphalt shingles, and metal roofing. New roofing systems will consist of a two-ply SBS modified bitumen re-cover system, asphalt shingles, and sheet metal roofing, as applicable.

All prefinished metal coping caps, flashings, accessories, and terminations will be replaced. Additionally, select buildings not receiving new roofing will be provided with new gutters and downspouts.
