Long Term Care - Expenditures

Nursing Facilities

- \$1 billion (combined State and Federal share) is spent on nursing facility services annually (fee for service only – this population is not under managed care).
- Ancillary services spend under fee schedule: \$10 million.

ICF-IID Facilities

- An additional \$100 million (combined State and Federal share) is spent on ICF – IID facility services annually (fee for service only – this population is not under managed care).

Long Term Care – Updates July 2017

Nursing Facilities

- Effective July 1, 2017, methodology to define urban versus rural providers was changed to CBSA designations.
- This change provided \$12 million additional reimbursement dollars to NFs.
- Five providers were held harmless until July 1, 2018 (\$3 million impact).
- 0.1% inflation was provided to standard prices and capital component.

Long Term Care – Updates July 2018

Nursing Facilities

- CBSA hold-harmless expires;
- 0.1% inflation;
- January – March 2019: All price-based nursing facilities will be appraised with updated depreciated replacement costs to be used in July 1, 2019 rates.

Long Term Care – Updates July 2018

KLCOS (Kentucky Level of Care System) and *benefind* Update

- Level of care regulations should be filed by August 15, 2018;
- KLOC implementation by regulation effective date;
- System issues with LTC processing are on-going and addressed daily.
