Andrick and Henry's Story

A few years ago, Andria was living in an unsafe relationship; her partner physically abused her and her two sons, Andrick and Henry. CPS got involved to consider putting the boys into foster care, and Andria decided to exit her relationship, determined to never have her children removed from her custody. Meanwhile, Andrick and Henry struggled at school – their unresolved trauma led to acting out: running away from classes, fighting with classmates, difficulty making friends, etc. They were referred to Renewal and they began working through things and seeing their behaviors and interpersonal health transform. Their Renewal team have partnered with the boys to make such strides!



Now the boys don't get behavior calls from school, their grades have improved, and they've blossomed socially.
