


Annual Total Cost For In-State, On-Campus Students




Net Price

- Net price only includes students paying in-state tuition rates.




Kentucky Average Price



Students Receiving Grant Aid in Kentucky










3-Year Cohort Default Rate




3-Year Cohort Repayment Rate
