

- ▶ Does NOT Stop a Constable From Serving Their Community
- ▶ Does NOT Impact Any Current Constable or Deputy Constable

Removing Peace Officer Powers for **Future Constables**

Constables Can Still:

- ✓ Serve Summonses and Subpoenas
- ✓ Collect Fees for Services
- ✓ Direct Traffic
- ✓ Provide Funeral Escorts
- ✓ Perform Duties Outlined When Position Was Created in 1850
