AN ACT relating to the certification of peace officers.
Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 15 IS CREATED TO
READ AS FOLLOWS:
(1) Any person who is at least twenty (20) years of age shall be eligible to be
employed by a law enforcement agency for the purpose of attending a basic
training course as defined in KRS 15.310 if he or she will be twenty-one (21)
years of age at the time of becoming certified under KRS 15.380 to 15.404.
(2) The Kentucky Law Enforcement Council shall allow a person employed under
subsection (1) of this section to attend a basic training course as defined in KRS
15.310 if the person will be twenty-one (21) years of age by the conclusion of the
basic training course.
→SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 67C IS CREATED TO
READ AS FOLLOWS:
(1) Any person who is at least twenty (20) years of age shall be eligible to be
employed by a consolidated local government police force for the purpose of
attending a basic training course as defined in KRS 15.310 if he or she will be
twenty-one (21) years of age at the time of becoming certified under KRS 15.380
<u>to 15.404.</u>
(2) The Kentucky Law Enforcement Council shall allow a person employed under
subsection (1) of this section to attend a basic training course as defined in KRS
15.310 if the person will be twenty-one (21) years of age by the conclusion of the
basic training course.
→SECTION 3. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 95 IS CREATED TO
READ AS FOLLOWS:

13	(5)	"Revoked status" means that the officer has no enforcement powers and his or her
14		certification has been revoked by the Kentucky Law Enforcement Council under
15		KRS 15.391; and
16	(6)	"Denied status" means that a person does not meet the requirements to achieve
17		precertification status or certification status.
18	The	design of a certificate may be changed periodically. When a new certificate is
19	prod	uced, it shall be distributed free of charge to each currently certified peace officer.
