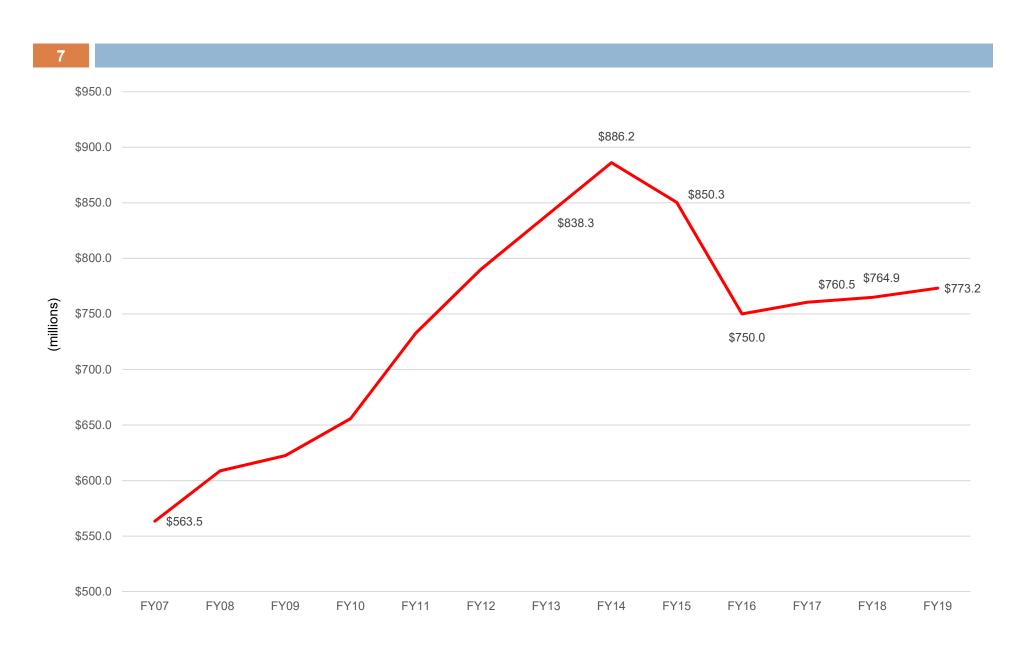

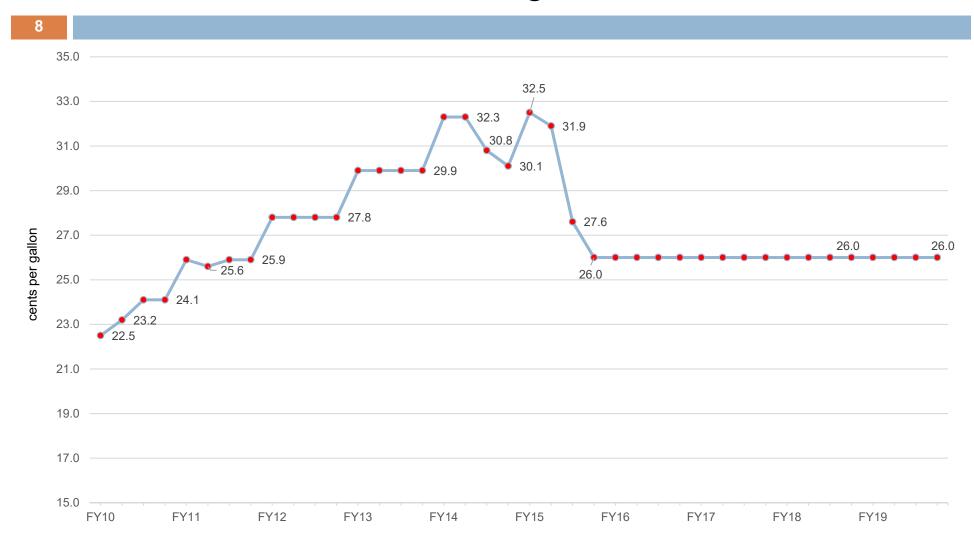

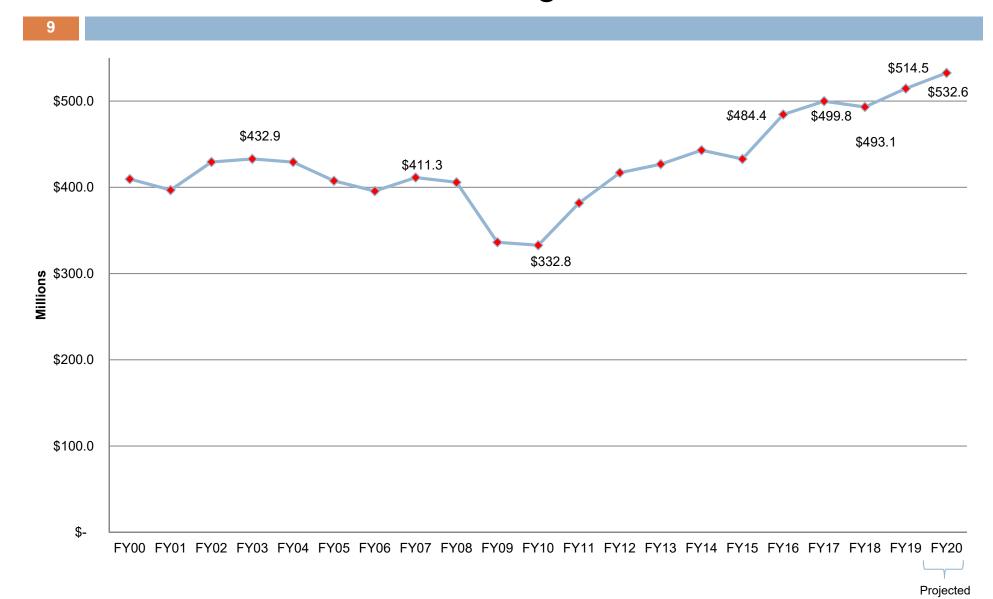
Historical Motor Fuels Tax Revenues



Kentucky's Motor Fuel Tax Rate FY 2010 through FY 2020



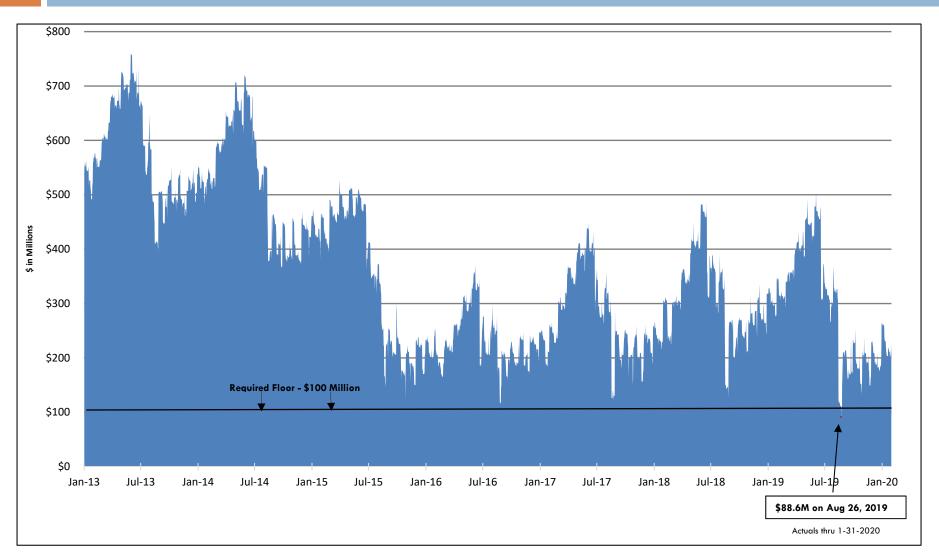
Motor Vehicle Usage Tax Revenues FY 2000 through FY 2020
