Update on Flood Damage in Eastern Kentucky

Secretary Gray, Mr. Ballinger, and Ms. Brewer provided a presentation updating the subcommittee on the recent weather-related damage in the eastern part of the state.

In response to a question from Chair Santoro regarding Kentucky's gas tax, Secretary Gray said his counterparts in other states feel that a federal infrastructure package is on the way, and expressed his concern regarding any matching funds that may be required to use those federal funds.

Chair Santoro commented that a fair and reasonable gasoline tax seems sensible in the current situation.

Secretary Gray commented that with the use of funds to assist with the severity of the recent weather-related damage, there would be fewer funds for new projects.

There being no further business before the subcommittee, a motion was made by Representative Heavrin to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Representative Huff, and the meeting was adjourned at 10:39 AM.
