64k Lane Miles of Pavement

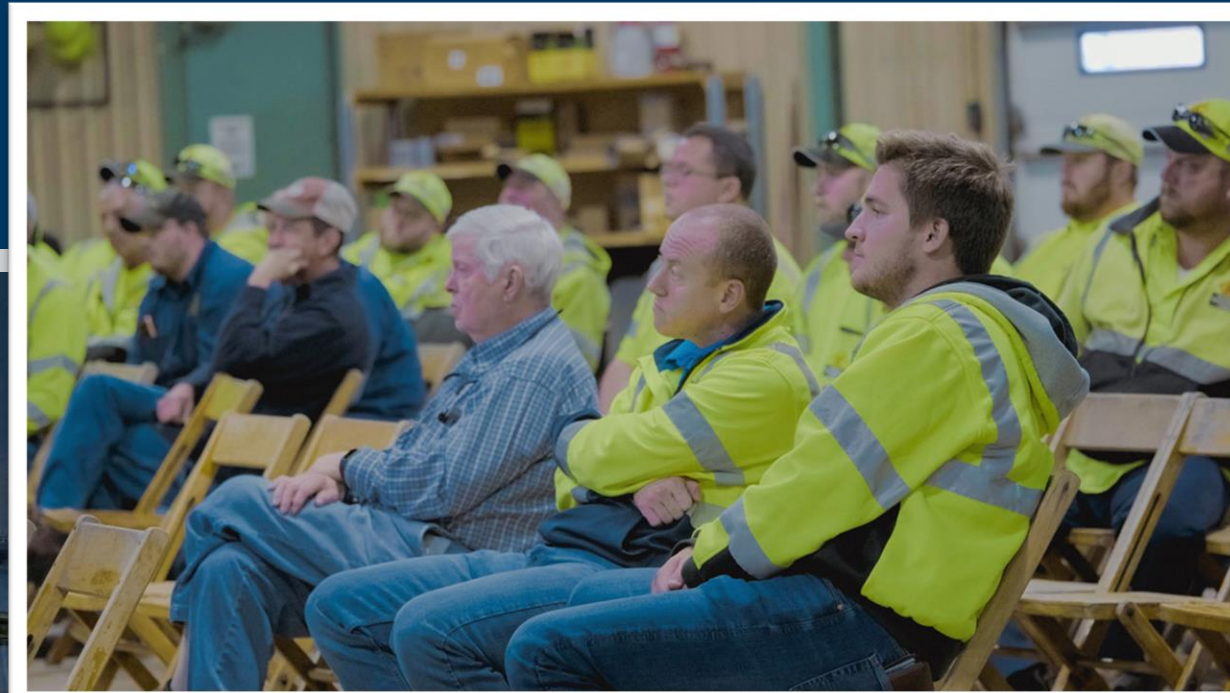

CLEARING A PATH THROUGH ICE AND SNOW

KYTC snowfighters:

- **Maintain passable roads during snow and ice events**
- **Clear fallen trees and debris on state roadways**
- **Maintain access to critical services**

Year-round, KYTC crews perform duties to minimize flood damage

SUPPORTING LOCAL COMMUNITIES

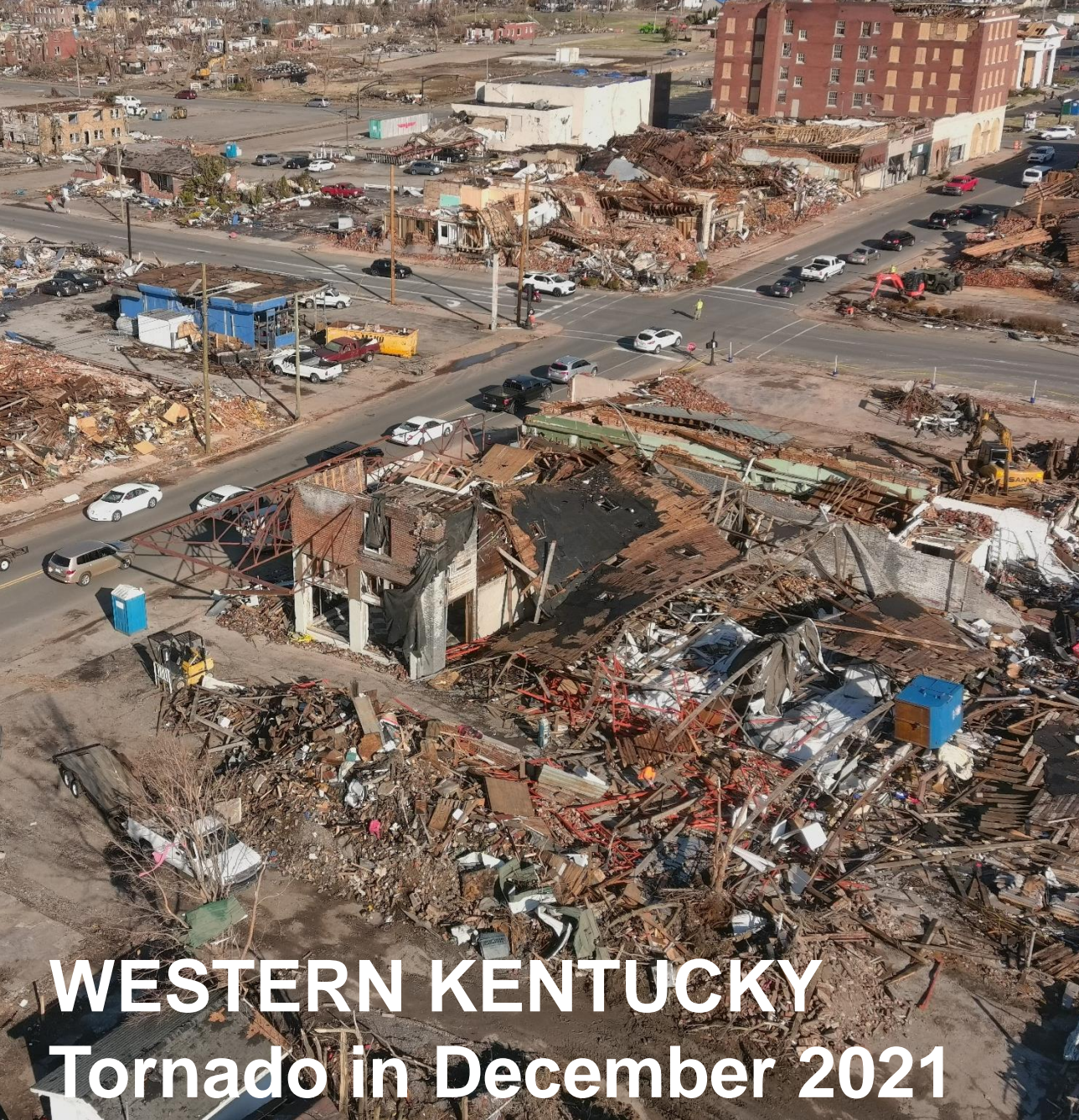
KYTC has worked with the Kentucky Division of Emergency Management to deliver:

- **Equipment to aid local governments in cleanup and recovery**

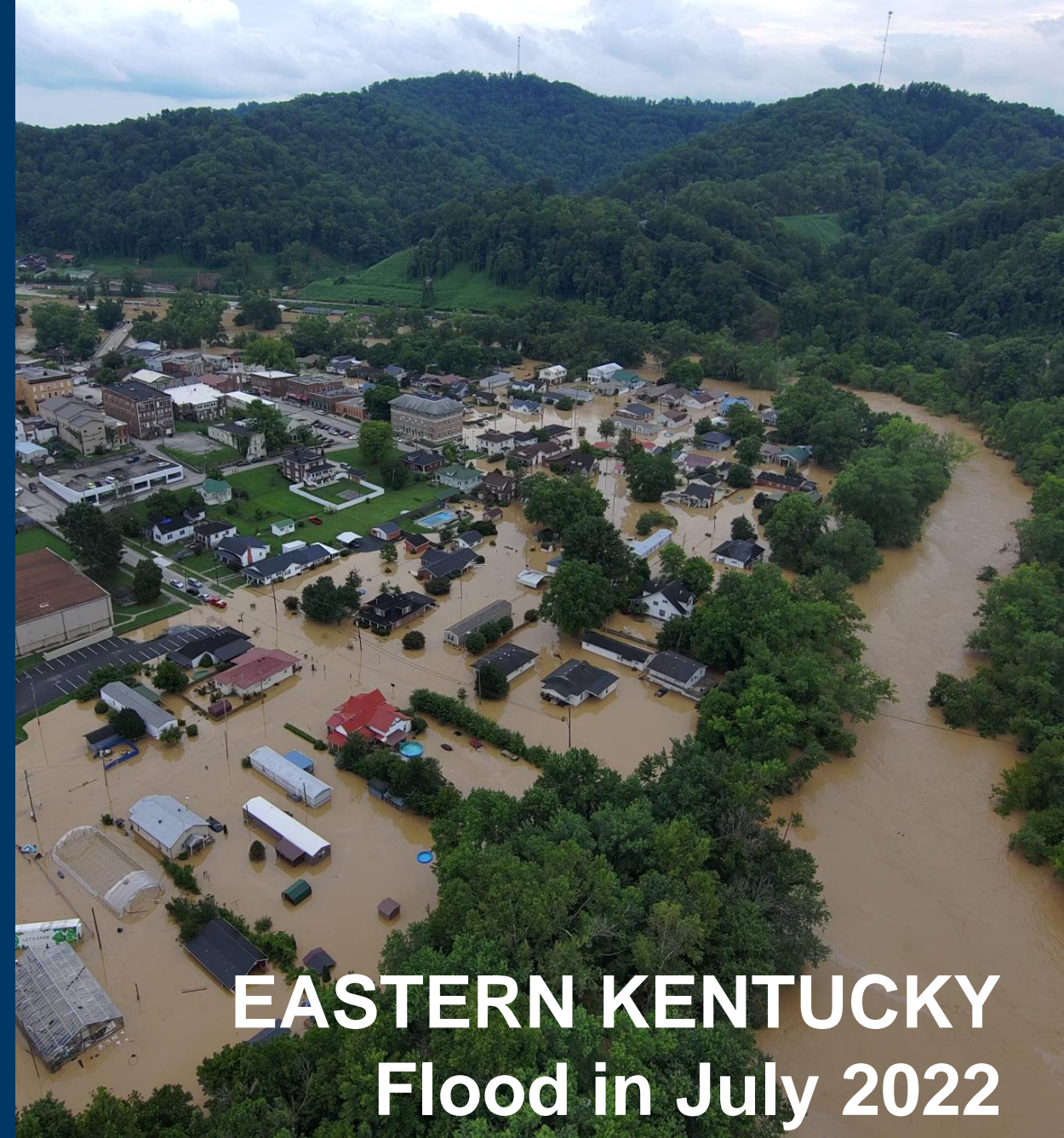
