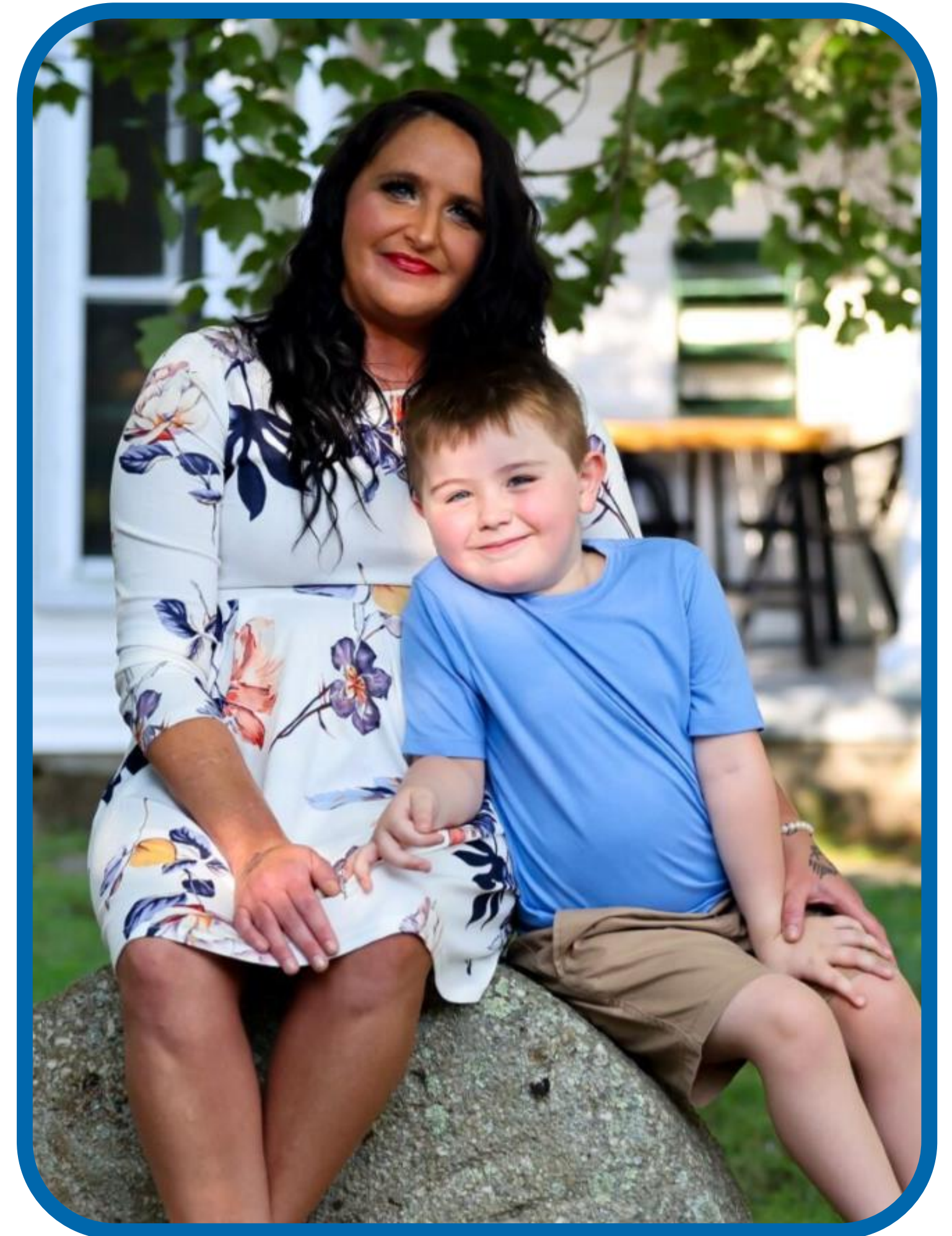

VOA Lines of Service



Evidence-based clinical services provided by licensed and trained treatment professionals with a focus on recovery

Around-the-clock care and service to meet our community's housing needs

Grassroots healthcare services and education for community members

Suicide prevention and supportive services to very low-income veteran families living in or transitioning to permanent housing

Housing and Employment services for adults with intellectual & developmental disabilities

Specialized VOA case management for justice-involved youth with the goal of reaching restorative justice outcomes

Freedom House

- A nationally recognized program, and the only of its kind in Kentucky, providing residential treatment for pregnant and parenting women with substance use disorder.
 - ALL children, regardless of age, may accompany their mothers into treatment.
- Data-driven and evidence-based treatment.
- We are doubling our capacity in Manchester to accommodate the demand for our services. Also expanding to Stanford, Owensboro, and possibly Northern Kentucky.



Freedom House

- Designed for pregnant and parenting women.
- We accept women at any stage in pregnancy.
- All children under 18 can live with mom at Freedom House.

Family Recovery Court

- A voluntary program for parents who are court involved and child protective service (CPS) active due to substance use issues.
- Eligibility for the program requires a Cabinet petition on the basis of substance use and said petition has been adjudicated by the courts.
- Immediate goal is sobriety and the long-term goal is family reunification.



Family Recovery Court

- A partnership between DCBS, AOC, Family Court Judges and VOA.
- Locations in Clay, Lincoln, Hardin, Leslie, Jackson, Rockcastle, and Pulaski Counties.
