WHY?

- ☐ PTSD affects 3.5% of Americans
- ☐ First responders are 5 times more likely to be affected simply due to their line of work
- ☐ 30% of first responders have experienced PTSD...
- ☐ 20% of those first responders who have PTSD have a substance abuse disorder

- Firefighters & police officers are more likely to die by suicide than in the line of duty
- Approximately 90% of police officers who commit suicide use a gun
- 6.6% attempt suicide vs. 0.5%
 National Average
- Over 131 thousand veteran suicides since 2001
- 2nd leading cause of death in veterans under age 45.
