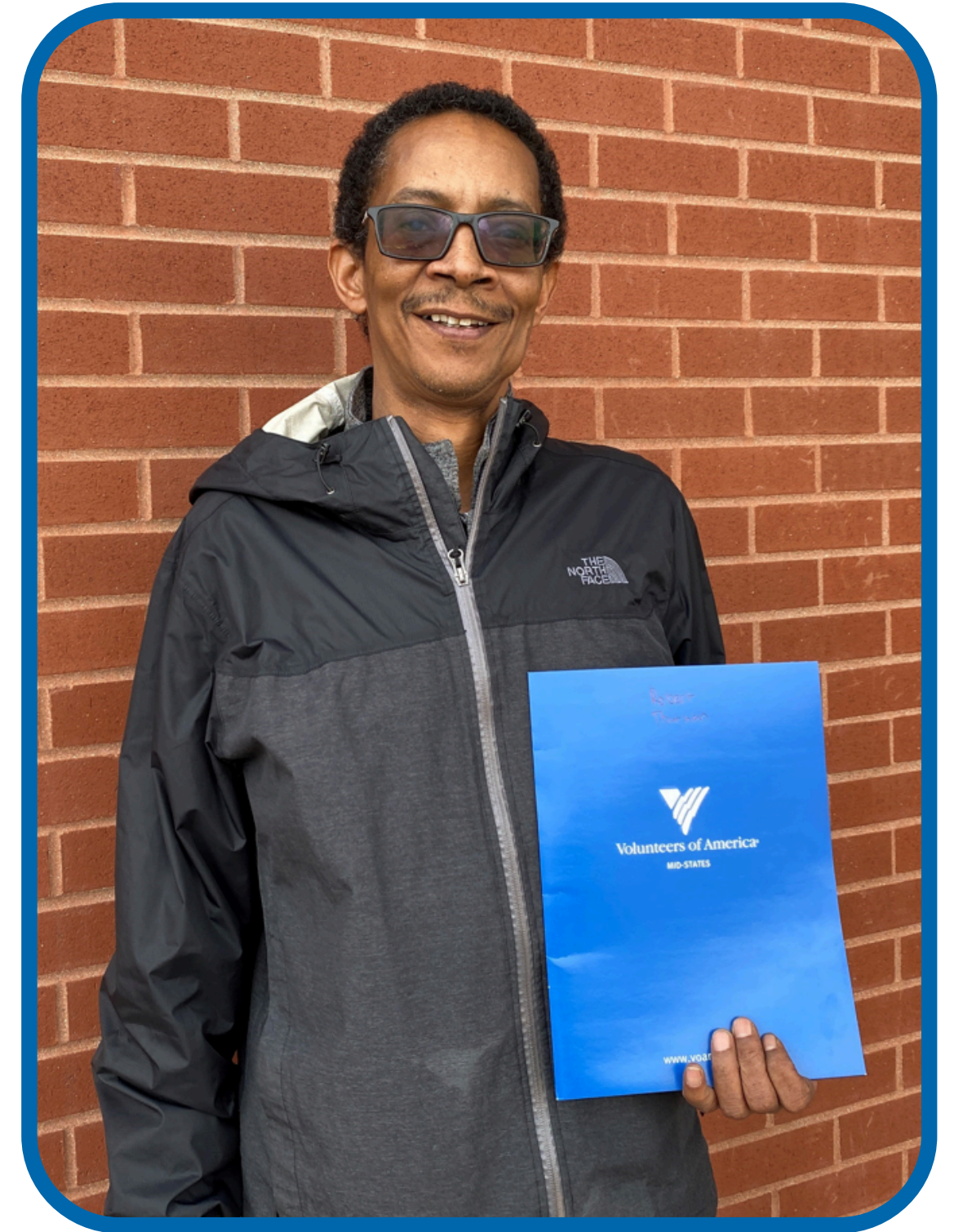


Our History

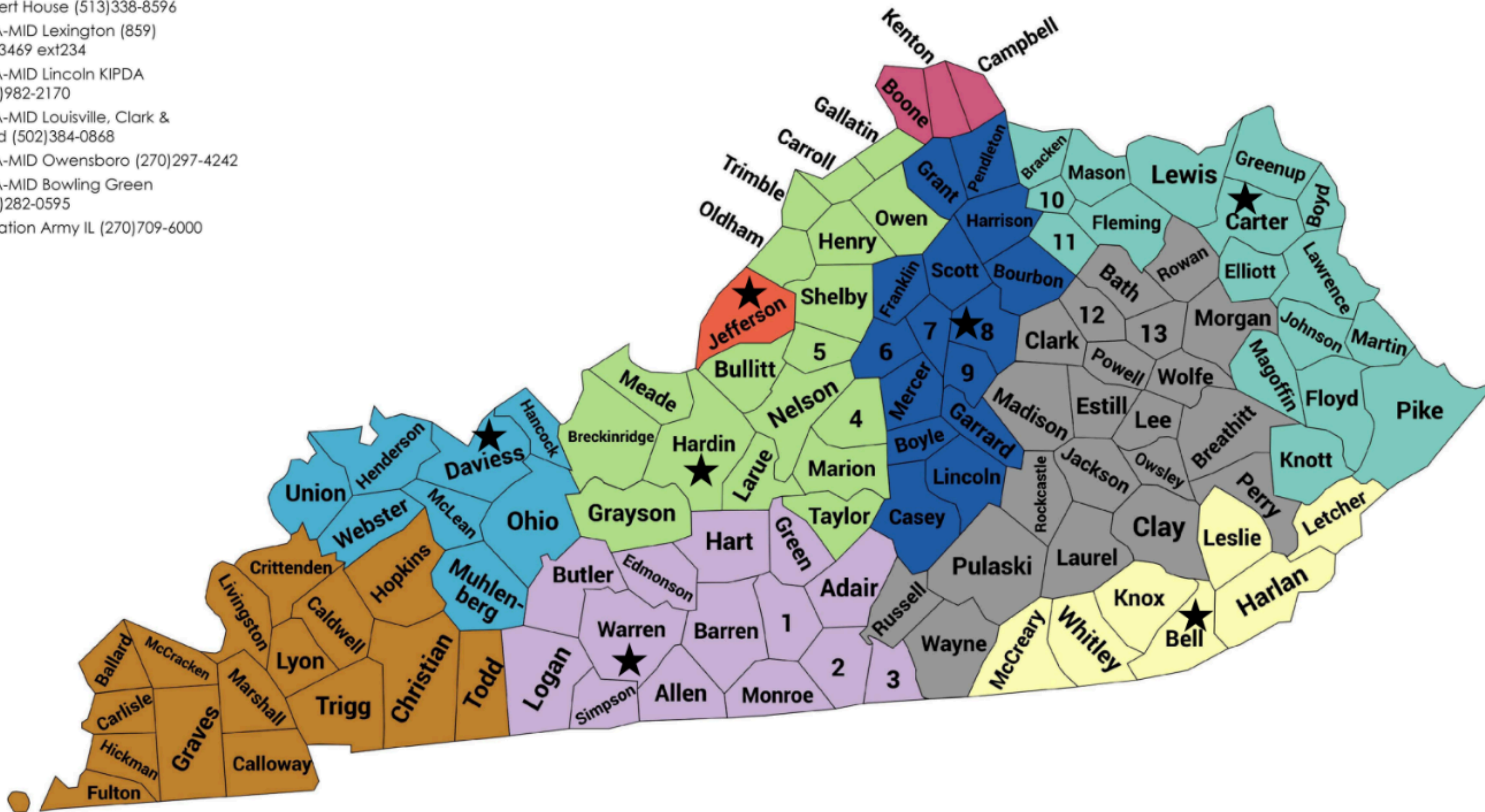
