Veterans find transition difficult



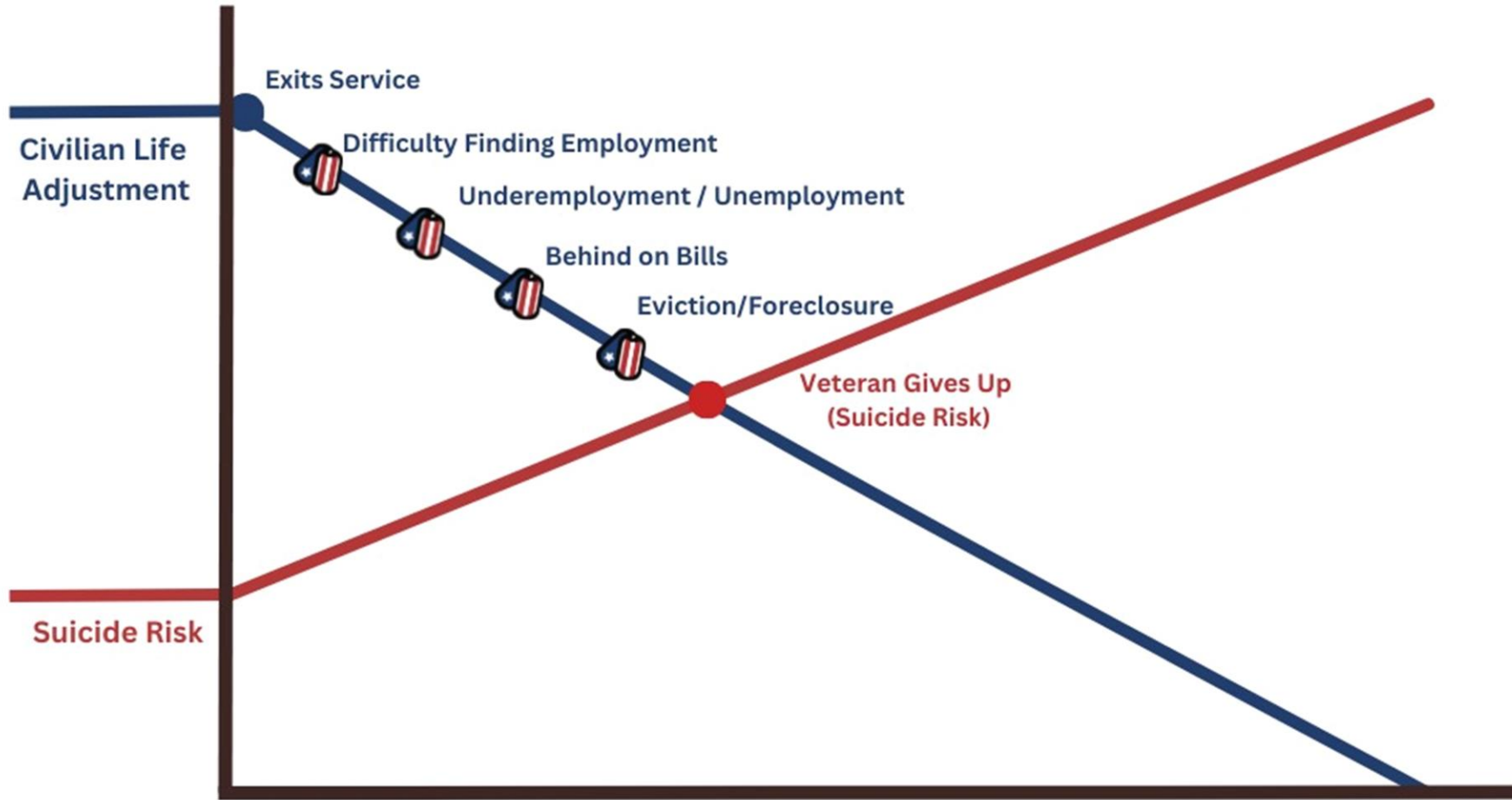

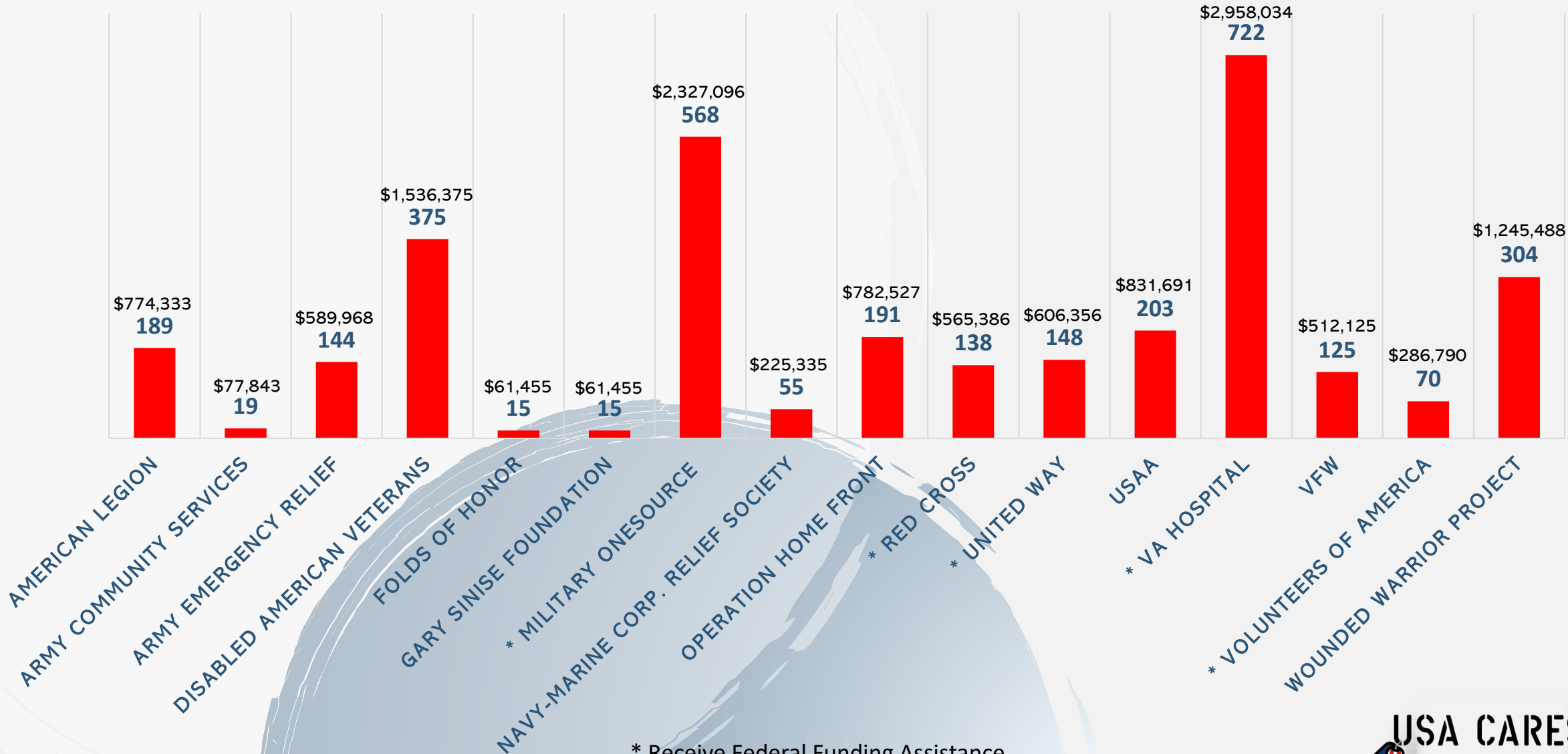
