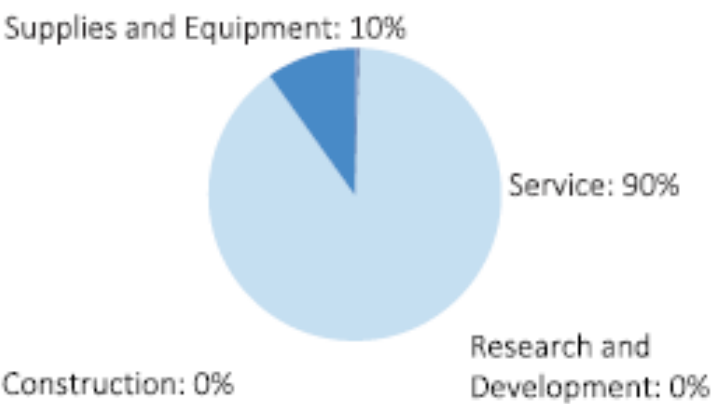

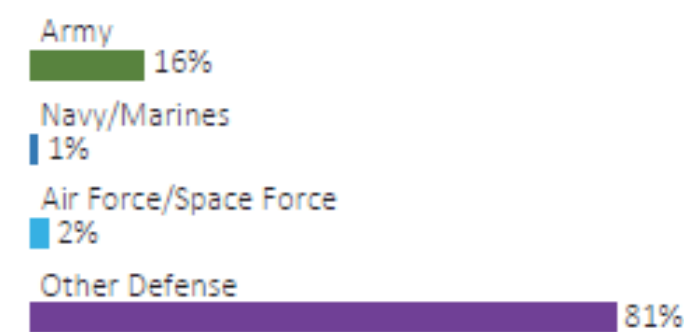

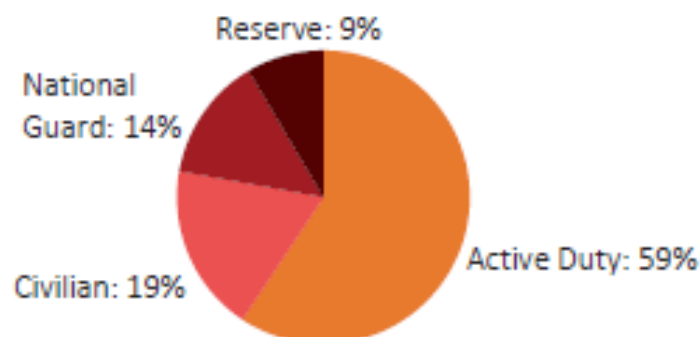
Contract Awards Performed

Allocations, By Service



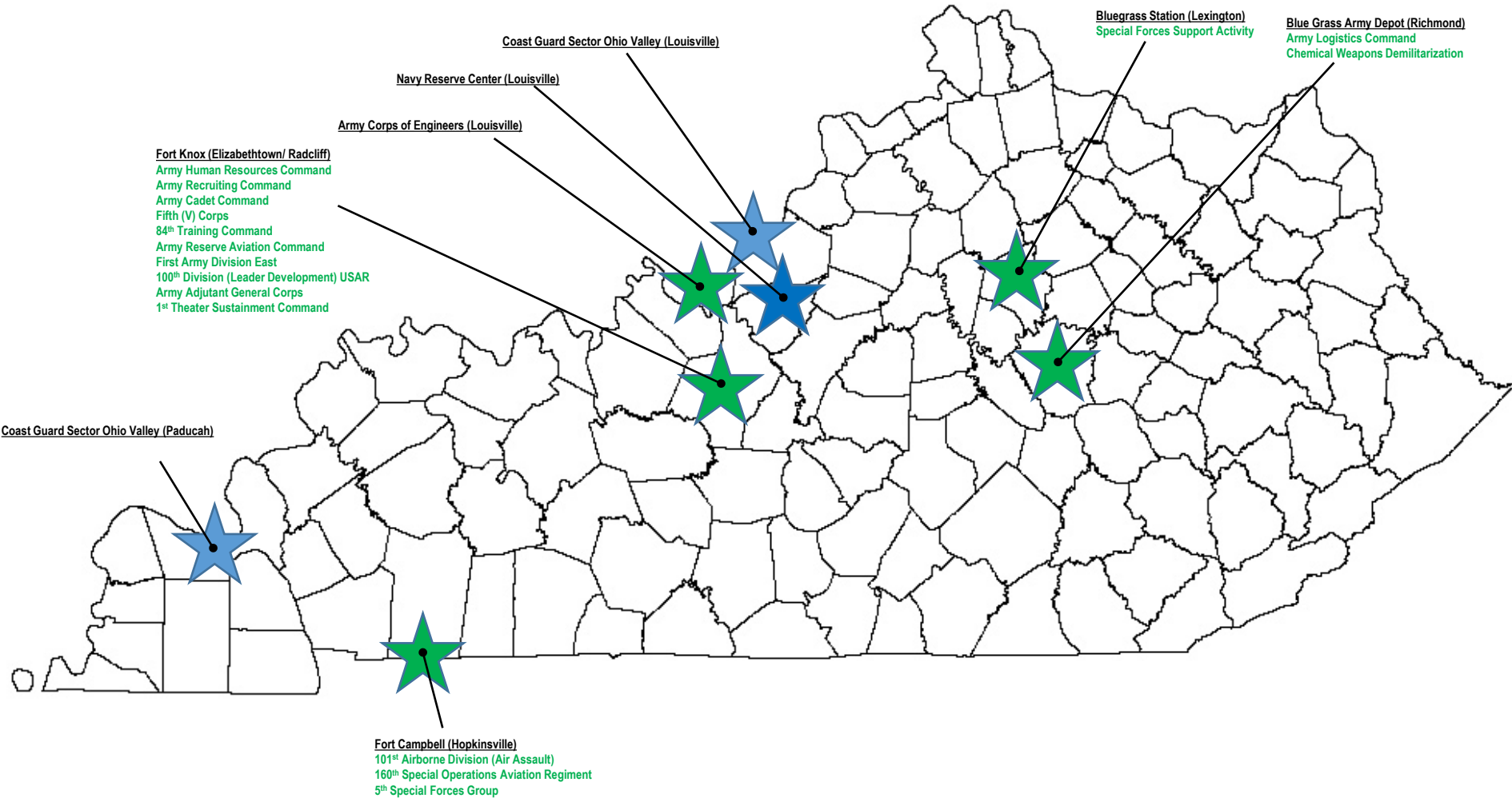

2025 Legislative Successes (short session)

PASSED

- HB 191 – Expands interment eligibility in Kentucky state veterans' cemeteries to include eligible National Guard and Reserve service members and their families
- HB 303 – Directs KCTCS to develop academic career pathways and integrated academic bridge programs to prepare military healthcare personnel for licensure in various healthcare-related fields

2024 Legislative Successes

PASSED

- HB 56 – DOD priority Social Work Occupational Licensure Compact
- HB 200 – KCMA omnibus legislation (Military Interstate Children's Compact Commission, Space Force, Army Reserve Aviation Command name change)
- HB 397 – Support for military personnel and spouses in occupational licensing
- HB 453 – DOD priority Child Abuse case reporting to military installations
- HB 469 – Purple Star Schools
- HB 471 – Support for Advance Enrollment of military connected students
- HB 715 – Military Family Assistance Trust Fund expansion
