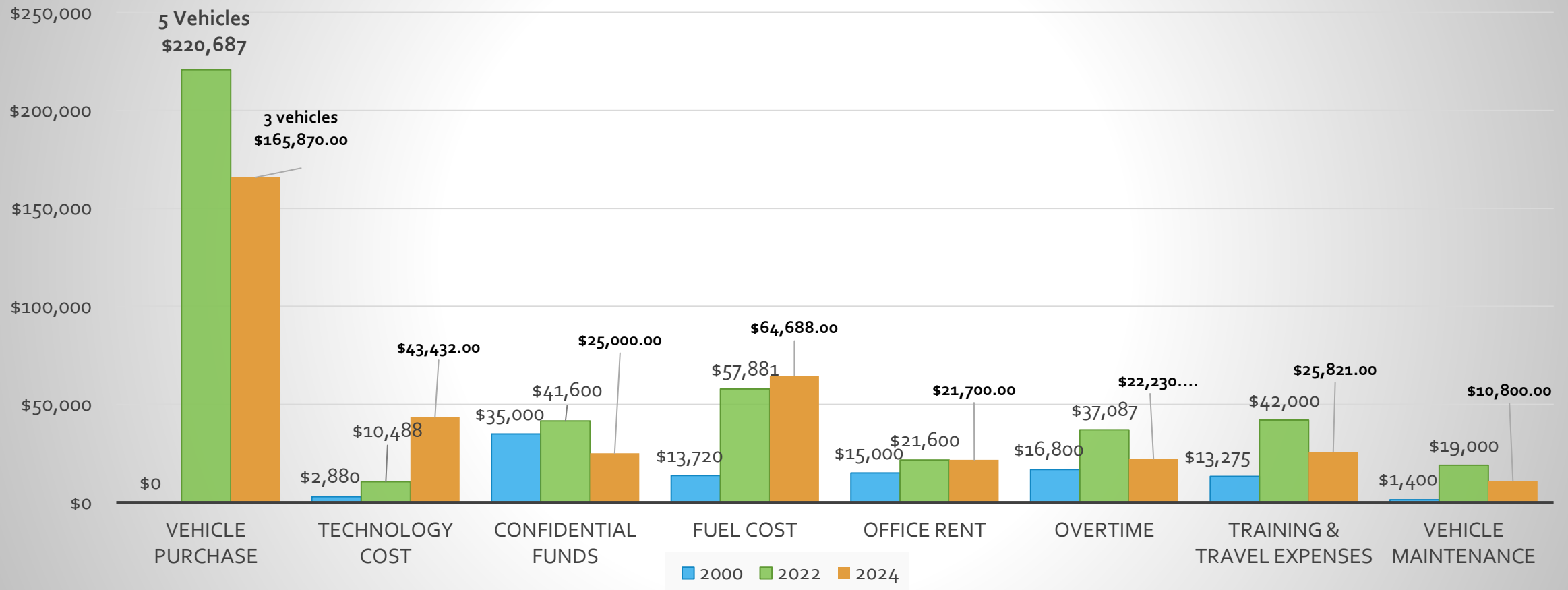

Operating Expenses

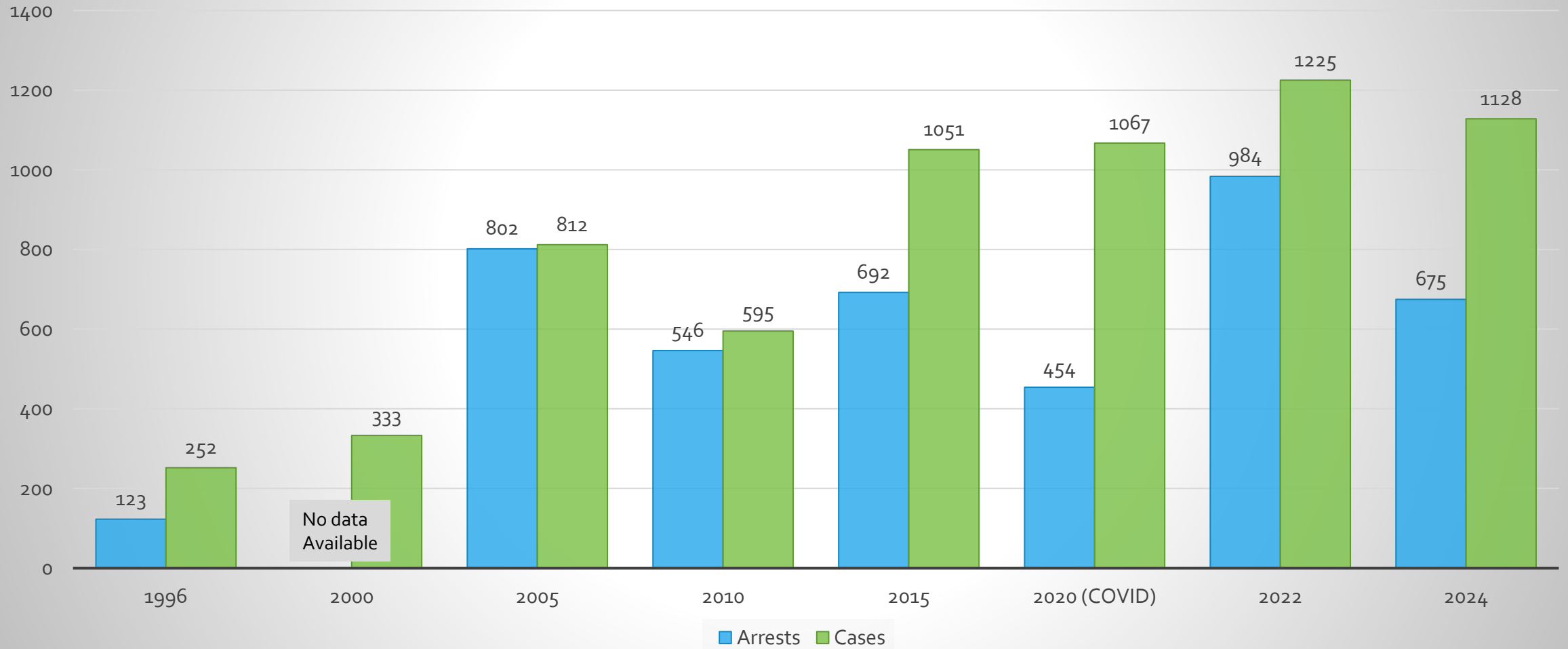

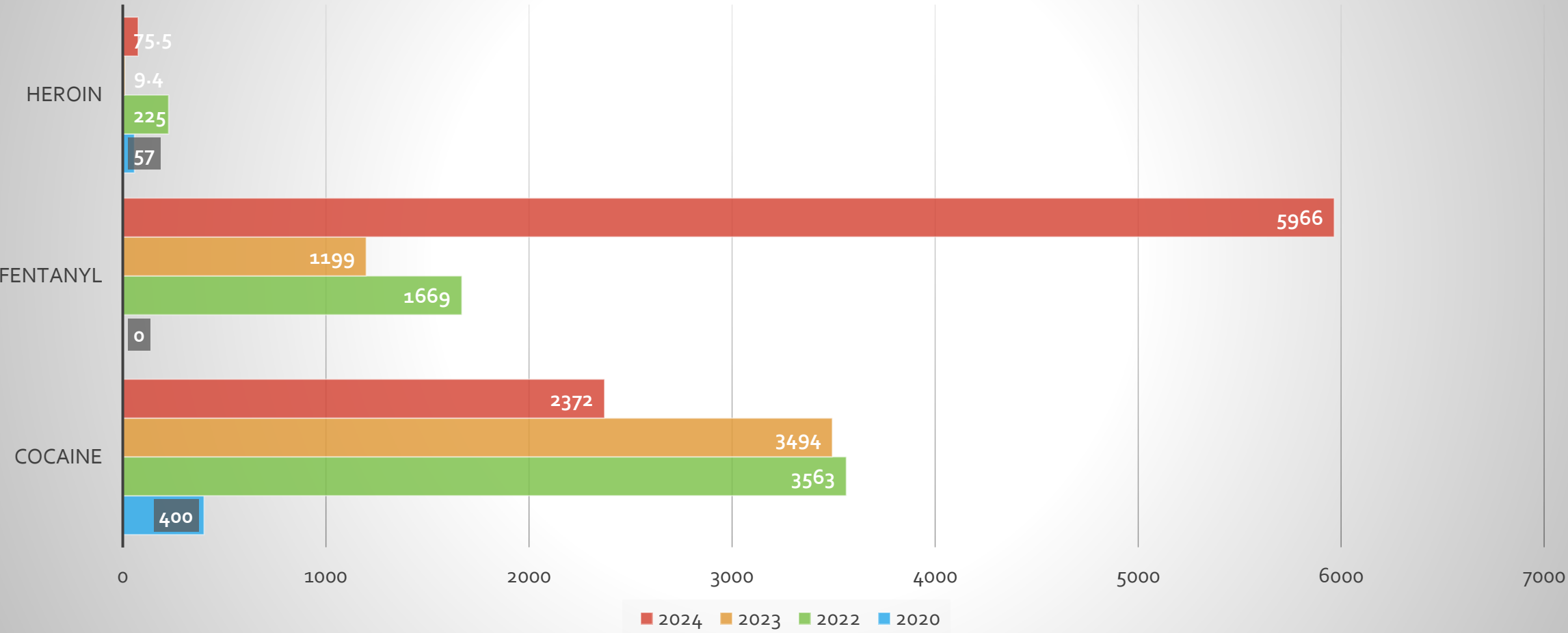

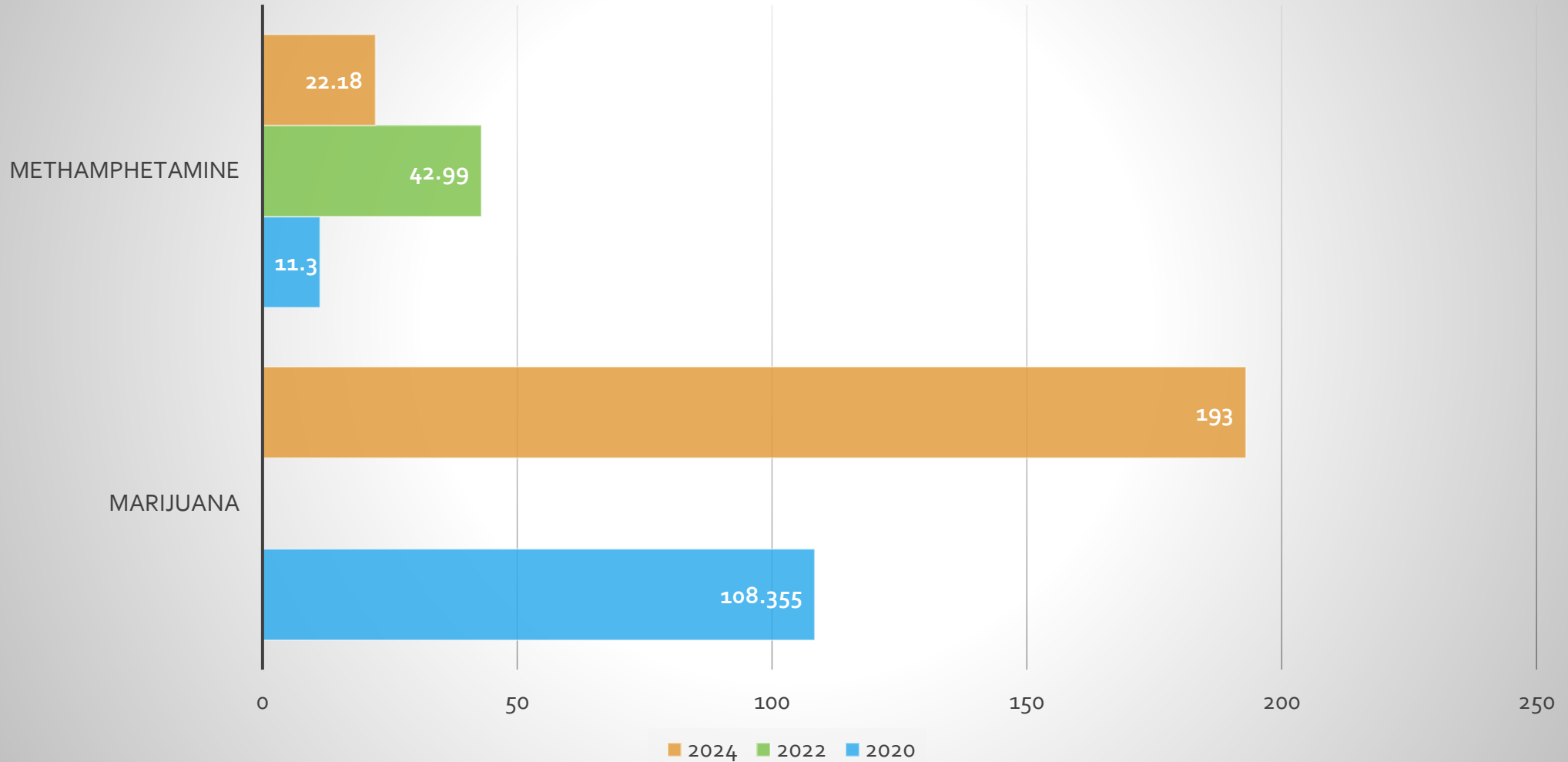

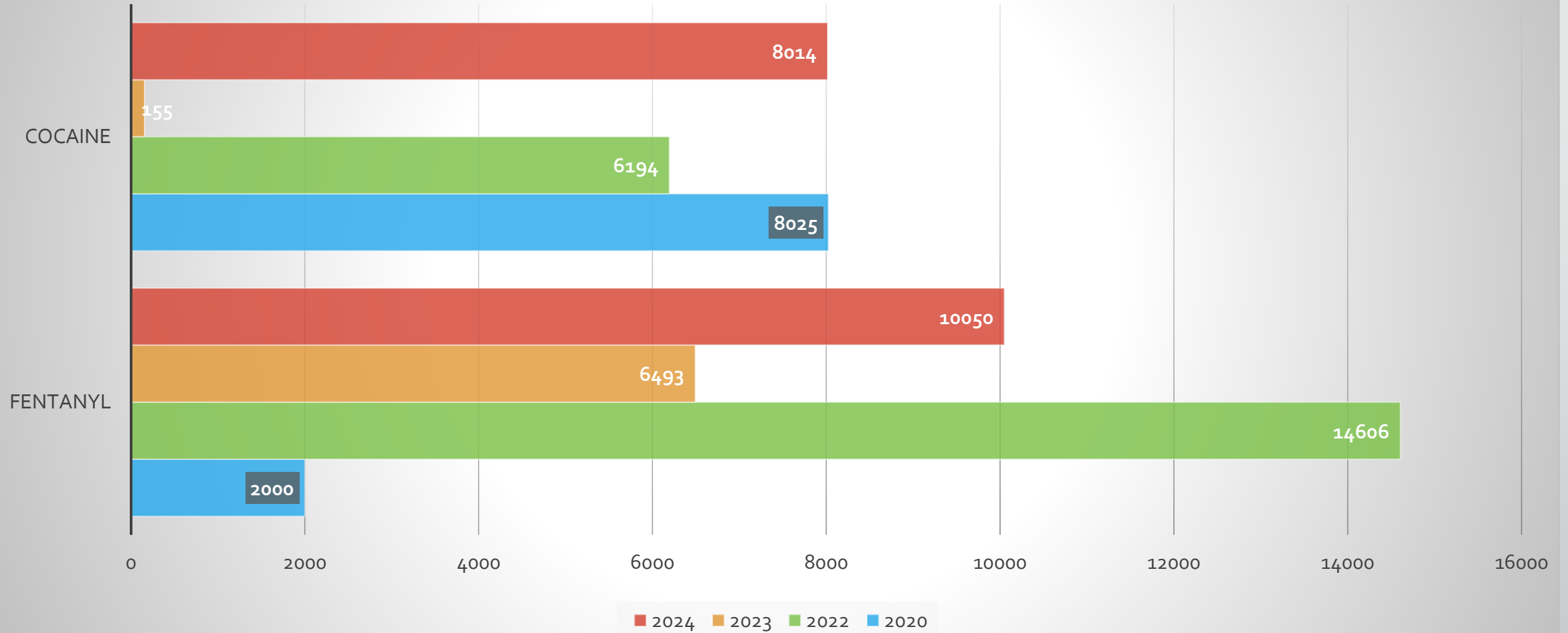

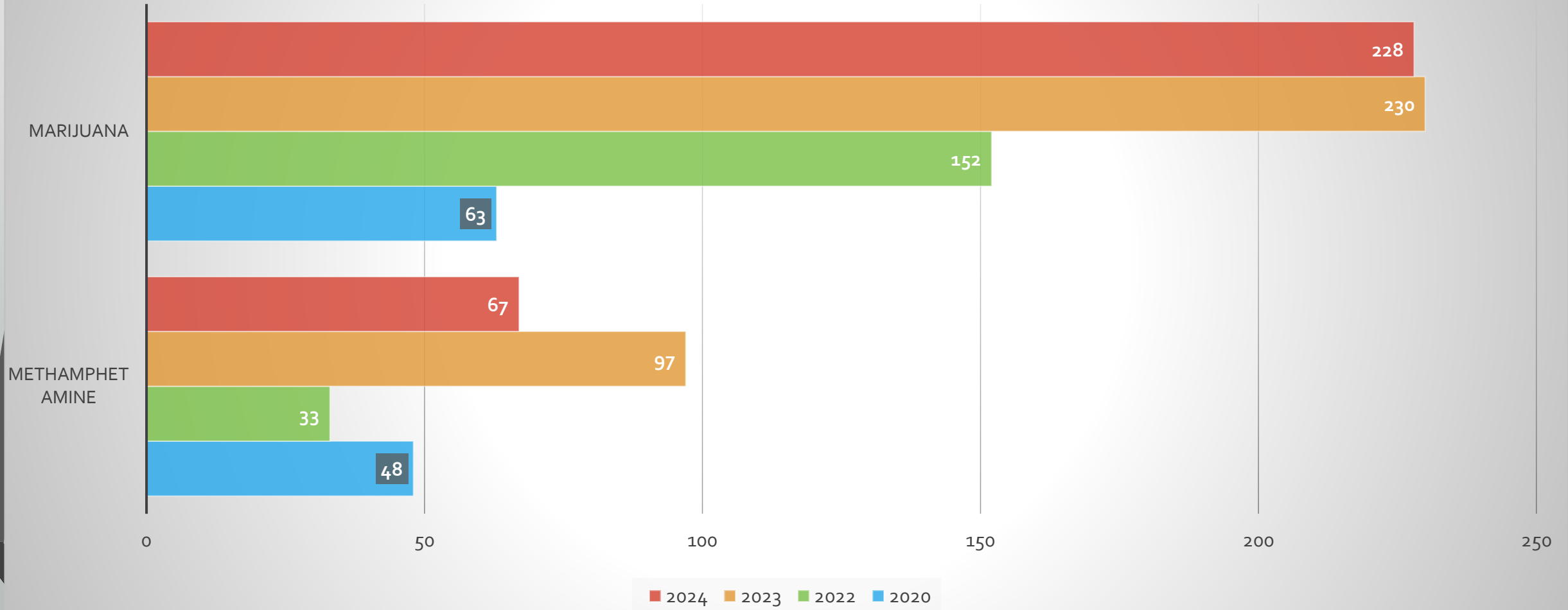
