Statutory Requirements

- Office of Health Policy -> Division of Analytics
- Reviewing and Evaluating Statutes and Regulations

216.2923 Health data collection powers and duties -- Analysis of health-care and insurance experience -- Administrative regulations.

- (2) For the purposes of carrying out the provisions of KRS 216.2920 to 216.2929, the secretary shall:
 - (a) Periodically participate in or conduct analyses and studies that relate to:
 1. Health-care costs;
 2. Health-care quality and outcomes;
 3. Health-care providers and health services; and
 4. Health insurance costs;

IQIs

- **Mortality** for inpatient procedures and for inpatient conditions

PDIs

- Selected indicators from the other three modules with adaptations for use among children and neonates to reflect **quality of care inside hospitals**, as well as **geographic areas**, and to **identify potentially avoidable hospitalization**

PQIs

- **Potential health care quality problem areas** that might need further investigation
- Measure of **primary care access** or outpatient services in a community using patient data found in a typical hospital discharge abstract

PSIs

- **Potentially preventable complications** and iatrogenic events for patients treated in hospitals
- **Screening tool** for problems that patients experience as a result of exposure to the health care system and that are likely amenable to prevention by changes at the system or provider level

Diabetes Long-term Complications Admission Rate (PQI 3)

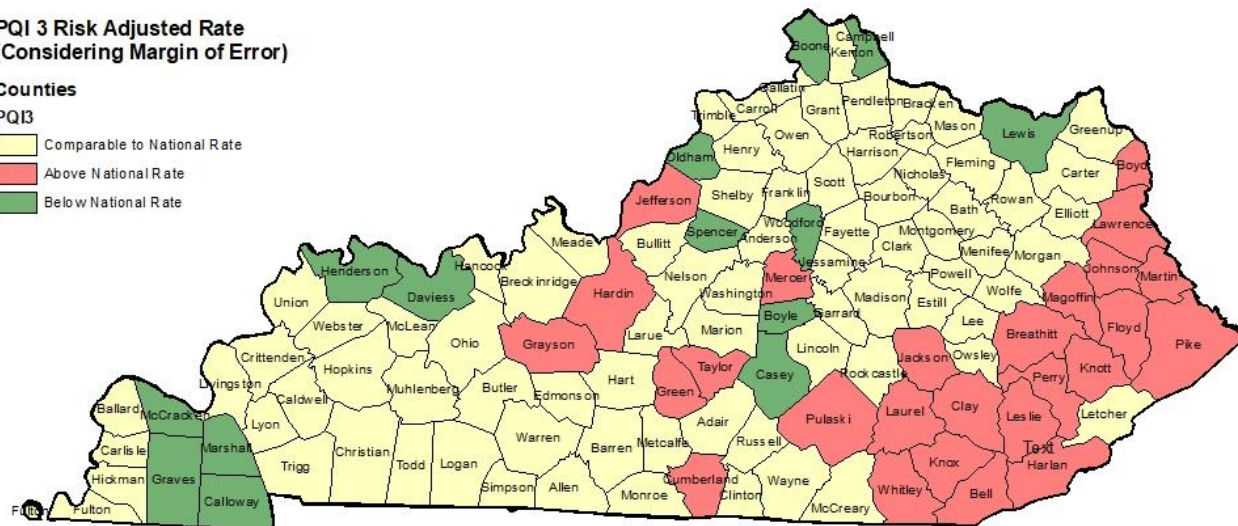


