### **Statutory Requirements**

- Office of Health Policy -> Division of Analytics
- Reviewing and Evaluating Statutes and Regulations

216.2923 Health data collection powers and duties -- Analysis of health-care and insurance experience -- Administrative regulations.

- (2) For the purposes of carrying out the provisions of KRS 216.2920 to 216.2929, the secretary shall:
  - (a) Periodically participate in or conduct analyses and studies that relate to:
    - 1. Health-care costs;
    - 2. Health-care quality and outcomes;
    - 3. Health-care providers and health services; and
    - 4. Health insurance costs;

#### **IQIs**

٠ Mortality for inpatient procedures and for inpatient conditions

#### **PDIs**

Selected indicators from the other three modules with adaptations for use among children and neonates to reflect quality of care inside hospitals, as well as aeoaraphic areas, and to identify potentially avoidable hospitalization

### **PQIs**

- Potential health care quality problem areas that might need further investigation
- Measure of primary care access or outpatient services in a community using patient data found in a typical hospital discharge abstract

#### **PSIs**

- Potentially preventable • complications and iatrogenic events for patients treated in hospitals
- Screening tool for • problems that patients experience as a result of exposure to the health care system and that are likely amenable to prevention by changes at the system or provider level




