






Marion County Detention Center Increasing Cost Factors Medical Services










Marion County Detention Center 5 Year Rising Trend "The Effect of Addiction"






CURRENT EVIDENCE BASED PROGRAM BEDS PER FACILITY




GED Completions 2018




MCDC Jail Vs. Private Prison






Housing Cost Comparison 2005 to 2017
