What is Next Generation 911?

- Analog
 - Copper wire
 - Voice-only
- Next Generation 911 (NG911)
 - IP-based
 - Voice, text, photo, video
 - Ability to share data across entire network



Federal NG911 Grant Program

- \$109,250,000 program funded by National Telecommunications and Information Administration & U.S. Department of Commerce and National Highway Safety Administration.
 - Grant objective advance states' NG911 initiatives
 - Award amount is formula-based.
 - Kentucky's share (if approved) = \$1,710,373
 - Required 40% local match = \$1,140,248
 - Total project = \$2,850,621



Courses of action to consider

- 1. Update Kentucky 911 plan (created in 2009)
- 2. Develop statewide GIS capabilities
- 3. Implement statewide text-to-911
- 4. Create statewide network



Where wireless 911 money flows

- Of every dollar in 911 fees collected from wireless customers,
 95 cents (soon to be 97.5 cents) flow back to PSAPs:
 - 37.5 cents = PSAPs based on call volume
 - 37.5 cents = PSAPs based on pro rata share
 - 10.0 cents = PSAPs through competitive grant fund
 - 2.5 cents = Provider cost recovery (to end in 2020)
 - 2.5 cents = 911 Services Board administrative expenses




911 Services Board Revenues
