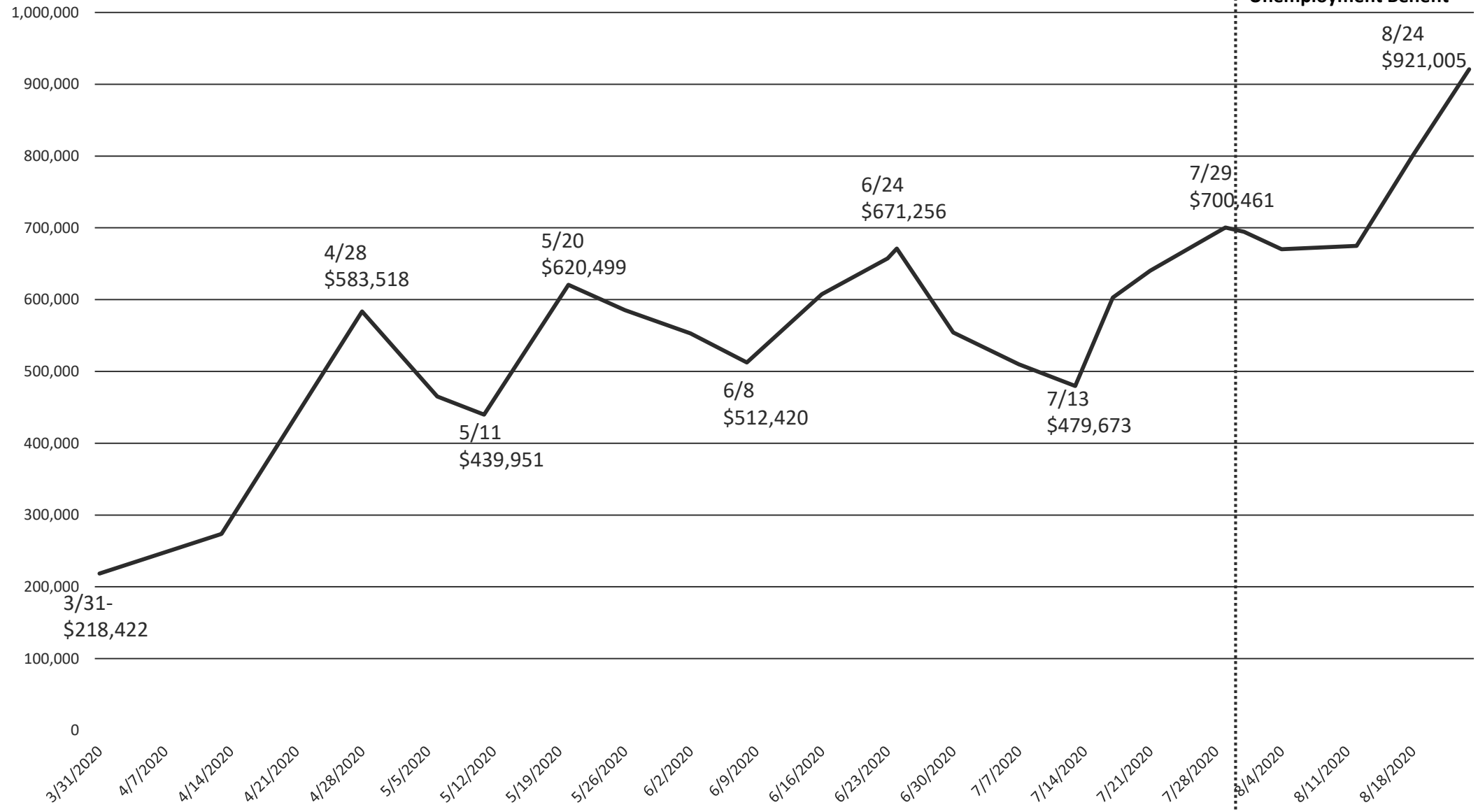

# REQUESTS FOR CONSIDERATION

1. Lift the May 8<sup>th</sup> Order
2. Modify the May 8<sup>th</sup> Order
  - Provide an end date, sooner than later
  - Apply only to residential accounts; commercial to return to normal
  - Allow utilities to assess late fees
3. Allocate and release CARES Act funds to local governments for Utility accounts.
