Reporting to Fire Commission



Agencies are mailed and emailed forms and instructions in May



Data is collected July 1 through September 1

Late reports are accepted, but may not appear on LRC report in October



Report prepared for LRC mid October



Commission continues efforts to acquire reports throughout the year



Agencies that remain Non-compliant are held to penalties outlined in KRS 95A.055

Overview

At time of submitted report 10/19/20

106 of 487 Non-compliant (22%) for FY20 Year End Actuals

Letters sent to all non-compliant

At reporting time last year Non-compliance was at 17%

Some reasons for higher Non-compliance:

- Covid19 causing delays and meeting cancellations
- DLG inadvertently sent correspondence to agencies that should report to Fire Commission causing some confusion

Yearly Comparison

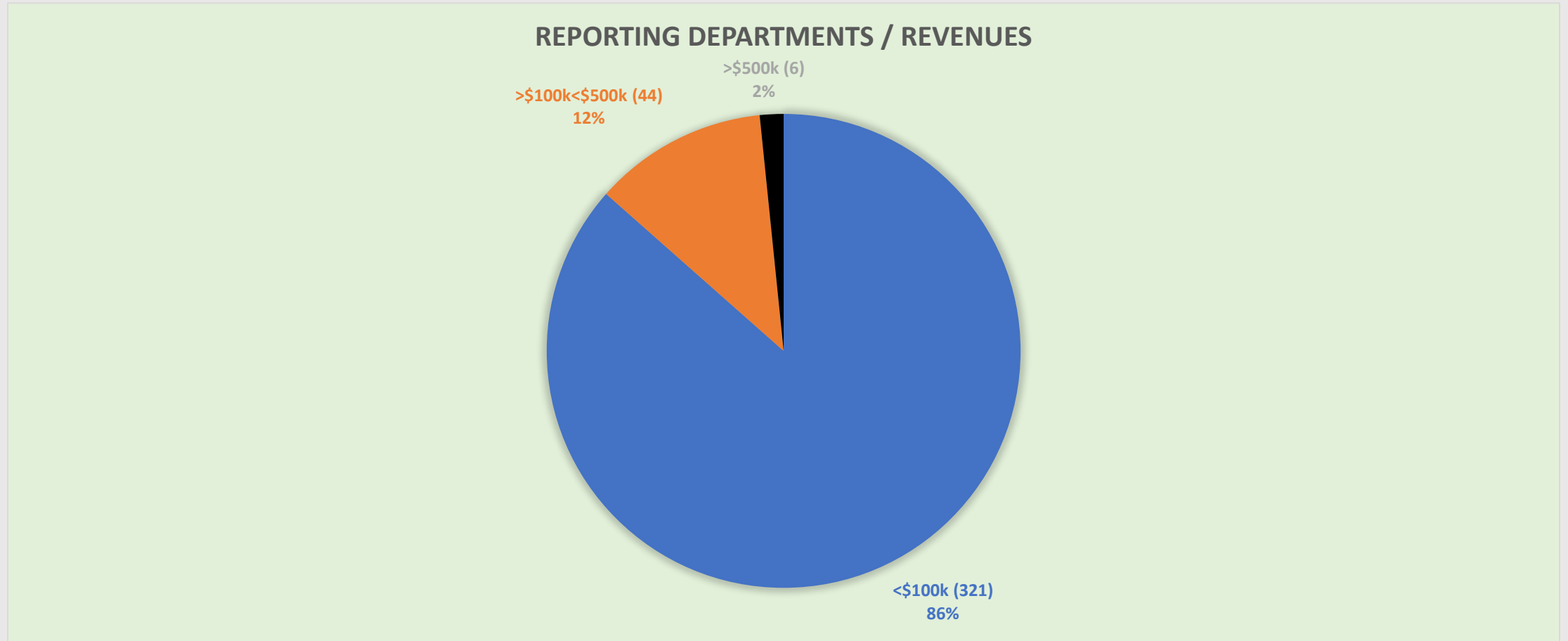
- FY18 458 of **460** Complied with reporting (99%)
- FY19 492 of **499** Complied with reporting (98%)
- FY20 381 of **487** reported to Fire Commission thus far (78%)
