ARPA Overview

- **Total county allocation for Kentucky:** \$867.8 million
- **Administration:** Direct distribution from the U.S. Treasury
- **Distribution:** Counties were able to request the first half last May and are eligible to receive the second half one year after the first. Many counties have already received the second tranche.
- **Timeline:** Counties have until **Dec. 31, 2024** to obligate funds and all funds must be expended and all work performed and completed by **Dec. 31, 2026**.



Reporting Requirements

6	NEUs	Not required		

- Counties are required to provide reports to the US Treasury quarterly or annually depending on their allocation.
- Most Kentucky counties are required to report annually.



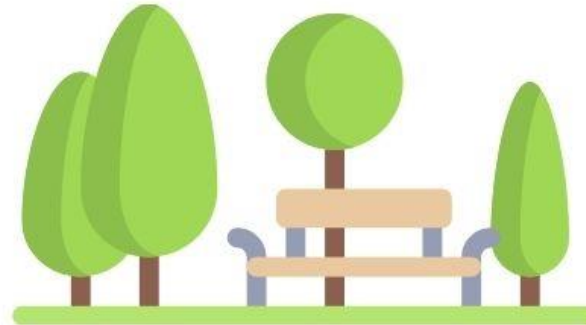
