

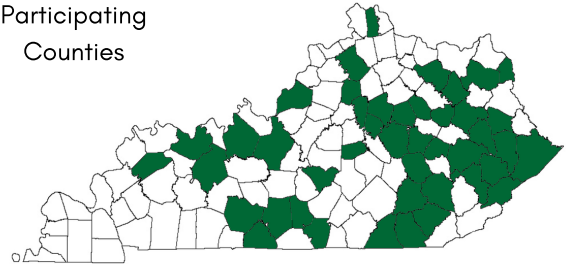
KENTUCKY DOUBLE DOLLARS

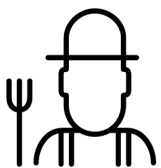


Kentucky Double Dollars offers financial incentives for individuals participating in SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) and the WIC (Women, Infants, & Children) and Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Programs to purchase Kentucky-grown produce and other agricultural products at participating farmers' markets, Fresh Stop and community markets, and retail sites. Kentucky Double Dollars serves Kentuckians by increasing access to local food, creates additional income for farmers, and helps farmers markets and local food systems grow.

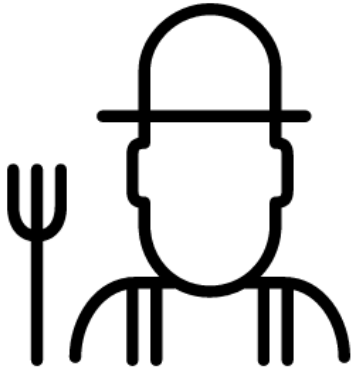
