



Built to Last

After 15 years, the following is allowable:

- Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning Systems and Controls
- ADA Compliance
- Life Safety and Security Systems
- Roofing Systems, Flashings and Accessories

After 30 years, a major renovation is allowable:

- Including three or more building systems and an estimated cost of 20% of the current replacement cost of the building, or portion thereof.
- The building shall be a minimum of 30 years old or 30 years shall have passed since its last major renovation with the exception of restructuring an open space school for conventional classrooms.





E-Cigarettes were the most popular tobacco product for the 10th year in a row




More than 2.1 million youth currently used e-cigarettes



Bathroom Layouts




Traditional Layout









Individual Restroom Layout









