Today:


- 23,000+ students

2024 Legislative Investment – Thank You

- \$450 million for UofL in 2024-25, along with an additional \$302 million in agency bond authority
- \$260 million Health Sciences Center Simulation Center and Collaboration Hub
- \$139 million in general operating funds, an increase of \$11.6 million, or 9.1 percent
- \$69 million over two years in asset preservation funds
- \$25 million to UofL Health's Center for Rural Cancer Education and Research in Bullitt County.
- \$15 million agency bonds for construction of J.B. Speed School of Engineering building
- \$10.6 million for the Kentucky Manufacturing Extension Partnership
- \$10 million cybersecurity center, addressing a critical need in a field vital to national security.
- \$6.4 million for pediatric cancer research, screening, spinal cord and head injury research
- \$1.5 million immigration law clinic at the Brandeis School of Law.









All Means All: Redefining Student Success, 2023 – present

- Top transfer destination for in-state students
- Retention (81.5%) and graduation (60.6%)
- Gold Military Friendly One of only 10 R1 universities in the country
- FirstGen Forward Network Champion one of 14
- \$2.4 million investment in need-based aid
- 450 registered student organizations
- Support services at the UofL Autism Center
- Student financial literacy programs

UofL Students:

- 117 of 120 Kentucky counties
- 50 U.S. states and 4 territories
- 90 countries
- Military Connected: 10% of our entire student body and 21% of online students
- 34.4% First-gen
- 42% Pell-eligible
- 28% students of color

It's working...

- First-time, full-time students: 2,967, up from 2,917 reported in fall 2023. This is the largest UofL class in recent history.
- Housing: Record-breaking 97% occupancy with more than 3,900 housing assignments.
- Transfers: UofL welcomed 868 transfer students in fall 2021. That number jumped to 1,207 in 2023 — a 39.1 percent increase in just two years.
- Retention: UofL's overall retention rate has reached the highest level in the institution's recorded history — 81.5 percent.
