


# Three Dimensions of U.S. Accreditation That Are Unique:

- U.S. Accreditation is a non-governmental, self-regulatory, peer review system.
- Much of the work & decisions are made by peer volunteers in the profession (emphasis on the practitioner).
- Accreditation relies on the candor of institutions to assess themselves against a set of standards viewed in light of their mission....it is a process of "guided self-improvement."




### Structure of SACSCOC




